This clock is designed to operate on normal 120V 60Hz AC power or on 4 x AAA batteries (for emergency use only). Do not attempt to operate the clock on any other power source. Do not connect it to an outlet that is controlled by a wall switch. When the power to the clock is interrupted, the bull in lithium battery takes over to maintain the time and alarm settings. 




