ANC Key

Short press: Switch the Transparency mode/ANC mode/ANC off When in ANC mode, double press to enter adaptive ANC mode, there is beep sound. (press one more time to exit to ANC off mode)

ULT key

Short press: Switch between multiple sound effects EQ: Vocal, High pitch, Bass (Note: switch EQ freely only in ANC of mode)

Quick double press :3D surround sound (Note: switch 3D surround sound freely under any mode)

You can also insert in 3.5mm cable and connect your mobile with the headphone and listen to the music from your mobile or computer.

02 How to use

03 Multi-Point Connection

1. Power on earbuds and they will auto become connectable. Connect them to Device A then turn off Bluetooth on Device A.

2. On Device B, search for Electro Sound Core and tap to connect.

3. On Device A, tap Electro Sound Core to finish Multi-Point Connection.

06 LED Indicator

When charging, the red light will be turn on. When charging fully, the red light will be turn off.
