Best for shoelaces, drawstrings, and kept in a pocket.






We are using shoelaces as an example, but this loop also works with drawstrings.



Thread the lace through the loop.



Tie laces normally.



Pull laces around Jiobit to secure down.

Best for waistbands, pockets, sleeves, and necklines.



Hold Jiobit in one hand.




With the other hand, twist and pull up on the clip at the same time to remove.

Best for belt loops, tag loops, and buttonholes.


