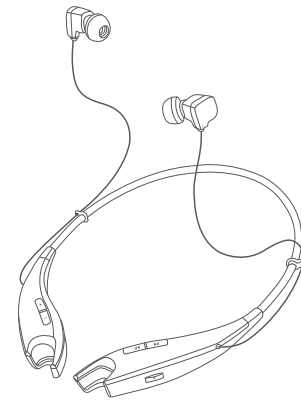

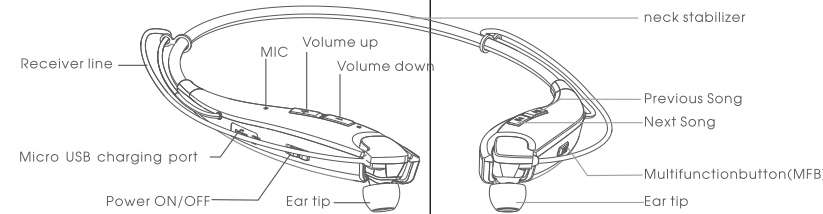
User Manual

Charging the headset

Charging the headset before use is recommended but not required. Every Mpow Jaws headset is pre-charged before it leaves the factory.

Voice prompt "battery low"

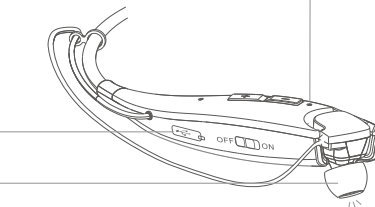
When the indicator turns into red and a warning sound of "battery low" rises, please charge your headset as soon as possible.

Micro USB charging

The full charge takes about 3 hours and can guarantee a 13-hour playing time.

LED status

Red: charging
Green: fully charged



Power on/off the headset

Power on:

Toggle power on / off button to "On", the green light flashes three times and the headset motor will vibrate twice. You will hear the voice prompt "Power On".

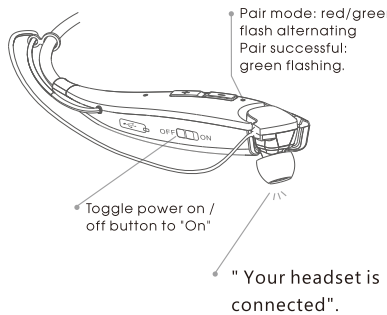
Power off:

Toggle power on / off button to "Off". The red indicator light turns on and the headset motor will vibrate once. You will hear the voice prompting "Power Off".

Pair it to your Smart phone

- Before using the headset for the first time, you must pair it with your phone.
- Turn on the Bluetooth function on your phone.
- Toggle power on / off button to "On" until the red and green indicator light start flashing alternately, you will also hear a voice prompting "toot toot".
- Search Bluetooth devices and select "Mpow Jaws" on your phone. Enter passcode 0000 if needed.

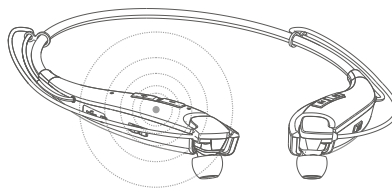
- If pairing is successful, the green indicator light will start flashing slowly, you will also hear a voice prompting "Your headset is connected".
- Pairing failed: Please turn off your headset and then repeat the steps outlined above.
- Automatic Connect: It will connect to the last connected phone automatically when it turns on. Please make sure the Bluetooth function of your phone is on before turning on the headset. If not, it won't connect to the last connected phone automatically.



Connect to two Bluetooth devices at the same time

- Pair the Bluetooth headset to the first phone.
- After a successful pairing, turn off the headset, and also turn off the Bluetooth function on the first phone.
- Pair the Bluetooth headset to the second phone.
- After a successful pairing, turn on the Bluetooth function of the first phone. Select the "Mpow Jaws" and click "connect".
- Two phones will both be connected to the headset at the same time.

The right side of the headset will vibrate twice every 2 seconds when a call comes in.



Answering a call

Press the Multifunction button.

Ending a call

Press the Multifunction button.

Rejecting a call

Press the "-" button until you hear a voice prompting "toot toot" and then release.

Redialing the last called number

Double press the Multifunction button.

Voice Dial

Press the Multifunction button for 2 seconds and then release, please make sure your phone support this function.

Microphone muting

When on a call, long press the "-" button until hear the prompting "toot toot" and then release to mute the microphone. When on mute mode, long press the "-" button until prompting "toot toot" and then release, the microphone will work again.

Playing music

Play/Pause: Short press the Multifunction button.
Next Song: Short press the "+" button.
Previous Song: Short press the "-" button.
Volume Up: Short press the "+" button.
Volume Down: Short press the "-" button.
