White light blink


- The white light will blink when metal foreign objects are detected on the wireless charger.

- All warranty claims must be submitted using <https://buyeeel.com/pages/contact> and require a photo of the product issue as well as the Order ID number. If the product was purchased on Amazon, warranty claims must be submitted on Amazon within the first thirty (30) days. After the thirty (30) day window, a warranty claim can be submitted directly to PEEEL through <https://buyeeel.com/pages/contact>. Product photo and Order ID number are required.
- When a warranty claim has been approved, customers will be sent a discount code to cover the repurchase of the product on PEEEL's online store. Discount codes must be used within ten (10) days of receiving the discount code.
- If a customer does not wish to repurchase the product, a warranty claim on PEEEL can only provide store credit equal to the value of the product cost at the time of purchase (shipping cost not included).
