After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- The block diagram should show the frequencies of all oscillators in the <u>TX of the device</u> (CFR 2.1033(a)(5)), unless this portion of the device is an OEM part. Please provide either the block diagram for the TX portions (802.11 + Bluetooth), or alternatively provide a parts list that shows that these parts are provided by another manufacturer.
- 2) Please add information from 15.105(b) to the users manual.
- 3) Is the data on page 17 peak or average?
- FYI....The users manual appears to be missing the required information for the DoC portion of the system required by 2.1077.
