The Mighty Max Floor Charging Kiosk is made for charging up to 10 mobile devices simultaneously via adaptor plugs.

L. Troubleshooting:

The device does not charge	 Ensure the power outlet is turned on and working. Ensure the thick black power chord is plugged into the AC adaptor properly. Ensure the thin black power chord is plugged into the underside of the charigng station properly. Unscrew the cover and ensure the cable is plugged into the USB outlet properly. Try another cable in the same USB port to ensure the charging is not damaged.
The charging port is damaged	Try multiple cables in the charging port to ensure that it is damaged. If it is still not working, please contact us.


We recommend a skilled electrician is used to assemble and disassemble the housing of the product to avoid risk of electric shock or electrical damage to the product.






