- 15.247 (a) (2) Systems using digital modulation techniques may operate in the 902-928 MHz, 2400-2483.5 MHz, and 5725-5850 MHz bands. The minimum 6 dB bandwidth shall be at least 500 kHz.
- (b) The maximum peak conducted output power of the intentional radiator shall not exceed the following:
- (3) For systems using digital modulation in the 902-928 MHz, 2400-2483.5 MHz, and 5725-5850 MHz bands: 1 Watt. As an alternative to a peak power measurement, compliance with the one-Watt limit can be based on a measurement of the maximum conducted output power. Maximum Conducted Output Power is defined as the total transmit power delivered to all antennas and antenna elements averaged across all symbols in the signaling alphabet when the transmitter is operating at its maximum power control level. Power must be summed across all antennas and antenna elements. The average must not include any time intervals during which the transmitter is off or is transmitting at a reduced power level. If multiple modes of operation are possible (e.g., alternative modulation methods), the *maximum conducted output power* is the highest total transmit power occurring in any mode.
- (d) In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated intentional radiator is operating, the radio frequency power that is produced by the intentional radiator shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement, provided the transmitter demonstrates compliance with the peak conducted power limits. If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of RMS averaging over a time interval, as permitted under paragraph (b)(3) of this section, the attenuation required under this paragraph shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. Attenuation below the general limits specified in §15.209(a) is not required. In addition, radiated emissions which fall in the restricted bands, as defined in §15.205(a), must also comply with the radiated emission limits specified in §15.209(a) (see §15.205(c)).
- (e) For digitally modulated systems, the power spectral density conducted from the intentional radiator to the antenna shall not be greater than 8 dBm in any 3 kHz band during any time interval of continuous transmission. This power spectral density shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b) of this section. The same method of determining the conducted output power shall be used to determine the power spectral density.

5.2 Digital transmission systems

DTS's include systems that employ digital modulation techniques resulting in spectral characteristics similar to direct sequence systems. The following applies to the bands 902-928 MHz and 2400-2483.5 MHz

- a) The minimum 6 dB bandwidth shall be 500 kHz.
- b) The transmitter power spectral density conducted from the transmitter to the antenna shall not be greater than 8 dBm in any 3 kHz band during any time interval of continuous transmission. This power spectral density shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of section 5.4(d), (i.e., the power spectral density shall be determined using the same method as is used to determine the conducted output power).
- **5.4 Transmitter output power and equivalent isotropically radiated power (e.i.r.p.) requirements** d) For DTS's employing digital modulation techniques operating in the bands 902-928 MHz and 2400-2483.5 MHz, the maximum peak conducted output power shall not exceed 1W. The e.i.r.p. shall not exceed 4 W, except as provided in section 5.4(e).

5.5 Unwanted emissions

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated device is operating, the RF power that is produced shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement, provided that the transmitter demonstrates compliance with the peak conducted power limits. If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of root-mean-square averaging over a time interval, as permitted under section 5.4(d), the attenuation required shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. Attenuation below the general field strength limits specified in RSS-Gen is not required.

Equipment Function

The EUT is a Secure Digital memory card (SD card) with embedded wireless communications capability for use in compatible aviation equipment. The design provides ability to add wireless functionality to transportation mounted aviation equipment. The design incorporates transmitter circuitry with operation capability across the 2,402-2,480 MHz frequency band. Multiple communication protocols are available, including Bluetooth® and Wi-Fi. Two test samples were provided for testing, one production design with integral antenna, and the other modified for testing purposes replacing integral antenna with RF connection port. Both samples required interfacing with the support SD cardholder for operation. The SD card holder provided USB interface for connection with the supporting test computer. The computer provided test software enabling testing personnel the ability to test operational functions of the EUT using available modes. The antenna modification offered testing facility the ability to connect test equipment directly to the transmitter output. The design provides wireless communications in one of two modes and requires authorization as composite equipment. The EUT was arranged in a testing configuration emulating user equipment for testing purposes. The manufacturer provided test software for testing the transmitter and functions. The software provided ability to operate the transmitter at near 100% duty cycle for testing purposes. The testing mode of operation exceeds typical duty cycle operation of production equipment. The design offers no other interface connections than those in the configuration diagram shown below. The EUT operates from direct current power supplied by the supporting system. Test results in this report relate only to the products described in this report.



Applicable Standards & Test Procedures

The following information is submitted in accordance with the eCFR Title 47 Code of Federal Regulations (47CFR), dated August 1, 2022: Part 2, Subpart J, Part 15C Paragraph 15.247, Industry Canada RSS-247 Issue 2, and RSS-GEN Issue 5. Test procedures used are the established Methods of Measurement of Radio-Noise Emissions as described in ANSI C63.10-2013. This report documents compliance for the EUT operations as Digital Transmission Systems operation.

Testing Procedures

AC Line Conducted Emission Test Procedure

The EUT operates on direct current power only provided by the installation. Therefore, no AC line conducted emission testing was required or performed.

Radiated Emission Test Procedure

Radiated emissions testing was performed as required in 47CFR 15C, RSS-247 Issue 2, RSS-GEN and specified in ANSI C63.10-2013. The EUT was placed on a rotating 0.9 x 1.2-meter platform, elevated as required above the ground plane at a distance of 3 meters from the FSM antenna. EMI energy was maximized by equipment placement permitting orientation in three orthogonal axes, raising, and lowering the FSM antenna, changing the antenna polarization, and by rotating the turntable. Each emission was maximized before data was taken and recorded. The frequency spectrum from 9 kHz to 25,000 MHz was searched for emissions during preliminary investigation. Refer to diagrams one and two showing typical test setup. Refer to photographs in the test setup exhibits for specific EUT placement during testing.

Antenna Port Conducted Emission Test Procedure

The EUT was assembled as required for operation and placed on a benchtop. This configuration provided the ability to connect test equipment to the provided test antenna port. Antenna Port conducted emissions testing was performed as presented in this document and specified in ANSI C63.10-2013. Testing was completed on a laboratory bench in a shielded room. The active antenna port of the device was connected to appropriate attenuation and the spectrum analyzer. Refer to diagram three showing typical test arrangement and photographs in the test setup exhibits for specific EUT placement during testing.



- 1—A LISN is optional for radiated measurements between 30 MHz and 1000 MHz but not allowed for measurements below 30 MHz and above 1000 MHz (see 6.3.1). If used, then connect EUT to one LISN. Unused LISN measuring port connectors shall be terminated in 50 Ω loads. The LISN may be placed on top of, or immediately beneath, the reference ground plane (see 6.2.2 and 6.2.3.2).
- 1.1—LISN spaced at least 80 cm from the nearest part of the EUT chassis.






Diagram 2 Test arrangement for radiated emissions tested on Open Area Test Site (OATS)



Statement of Modifications and Deviations

No modifications to the EUT were required for the unit to demonstrate compliance with 47CFR Part 15C, RSS-247 Issue 2, and RSS-GEN Issue 5 emission requirements. There were no deviations to the specifications.

Intentional Radiators

The following information is submitted in support demonstration of compliance with the requirements of 47CFR, Paragraph 15 Subpart C, paragraph 15.247, Industry Canada RSS-247 Issue 2, and RSS-GEN Issue 5.

Antenna Requirements

The EUT incorporates integral antenna system and offers no provision for connection to alternate antenna system. The antenna connection point complies with the unique antenna connection requirements. There are no deviations or exceptions to the specification.

Restricted Bands of Operation

Spurious emissions falling in the restricted frequency bands of operation were measured at the OATS. The EUT utilizes frequency, determining circuitry, which generates harmonics falling in the restricted bands. Emissions were investigated at the OATS, using appropriate antennas or pyramidal horns, amplification stages, and a spectrum analyzer. Peak and average amplitudes of frequencies above 1000 MHz were compared to the required limits with worst-case data presented below. Test procedures of ANSI C63.10-2013 were used during testing. No other significant emission was observed which fell into the restricted bands of operation. Computed emission values consider the received radiated field strength, receive antenna correction factor, amplifier gain stage, and test system cable losses.

The EUT demonstrated compliance with the radiated emissions requirements of 47CFR Paragraph 15, Subpart 15C, RSS-247 Issue 2, and RSS-GEN Issue 5 emission requirements. The EUT worst-case operations demonstrated a minimum radiated emission margin of -6.0 dB below the requirements in restricted frequency bands. Peak, Quasi-peak, and average amplitudes were checked for compliance with the regulations. General Radiated Emissions Procedure

The EUT was arranged in a typical equipment configuration and operated through all available mode during testing. Preliminary testing was performed in a screen room with the EUT positioned 1 meter from the FSM. Radiated emissions measurements were performed to identify the frequencies, which produced the highest emissions. Each radiated emission was then maximized at the OATS location before final radiated measurements were performed. Final data was taken with the EUT located on the OATS at 3 meters distance between the EUT and the receiving antenna. The frequency spectrum from 9 kHz to 25,000 MHz was searched for general radiated emissions. Measured emission levels were maximized by EUT placement on the table, rotating the turntable through 360 degrees, varying the antenna height between 1 and 4 meters above the ground plane and changing antenna position between horizontal and vertical polarization. Antennas used were Loop from 9 kHz to 30 MHz, Broadband Biconical from 30 to 200 MHz, Biconilog from 30 to 1000 MHz, Log Periodic from 200 MHz to 1 GHz and or double Ridge or pyramidal horns and mixers above 1 GHz, notch filters and appropriate amplifiers and external mixers were utilized.

Operation in the Band 2400 - 2483.5 MHz

Test procedures of ANSI C63.10-2013 paragraph 6, and KDB 558074 v05r02 were used during transmitter testing. Test sample #2 was provided for testing antenna port conducted emissions. This sample was modified by replacing the internal antenna with a 50-ohm antenna port connector and attenuator for testing purposes. The transmitter peak and average power was measured at the antenna port using a wideband RF power meter as described in ANSI C63.10-2013 and KDB 558074. Average power measured did not include any time intervals during which the transmitter was off or transmitting at a reduced power level. The Power Spectral Density (PSD) was measured as required in ANSI C63.10-2013 and KDB 558074. DTS Emission bandwidth was measured as required in ANSI C63.10-2013 and KDB 558074. The amplitude of each harmonic and general radiated emission was measured on the OATS at distance of 3 meters from the FSM antenna (radiated emission testing was performed on sample #1 representative of production equipment with integral antenna). The EUT was positioned on supporting turntable elevated as required above the ground plane, at a distance of 3 meters from the FSM antenna. Radiated emission investigations were performed from 9 kHz to 25,000 MHz. Each radiated emission was maximized by varying the FSM antenna height and polarization, and by rotating the turntable. The worst-case amplitude of each emission was then recorded from the analyzer display. The peak and quasi-peak amplitude of frequencies below 1000 MHz were measured using a spectrum analyzer. The peak and average amplitude of frequencies above 1000 MHZ were measured using a spectrum analyzer. A Loop antenna was used for measuring emissions from 0.009 to 30 MHz, Biconilog Antenna for 30 to 1000 MHz, Double-Ridge, and/or Pyramidal Horn Antennas from 1 GHz to 25 GHz. Radiated Emissions were measured in $dB\mu V/m$ @ 3 meters.

















Figure 8 Plot of Transmitter Emissions High Band Edge Mode 6 802.11g



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


















