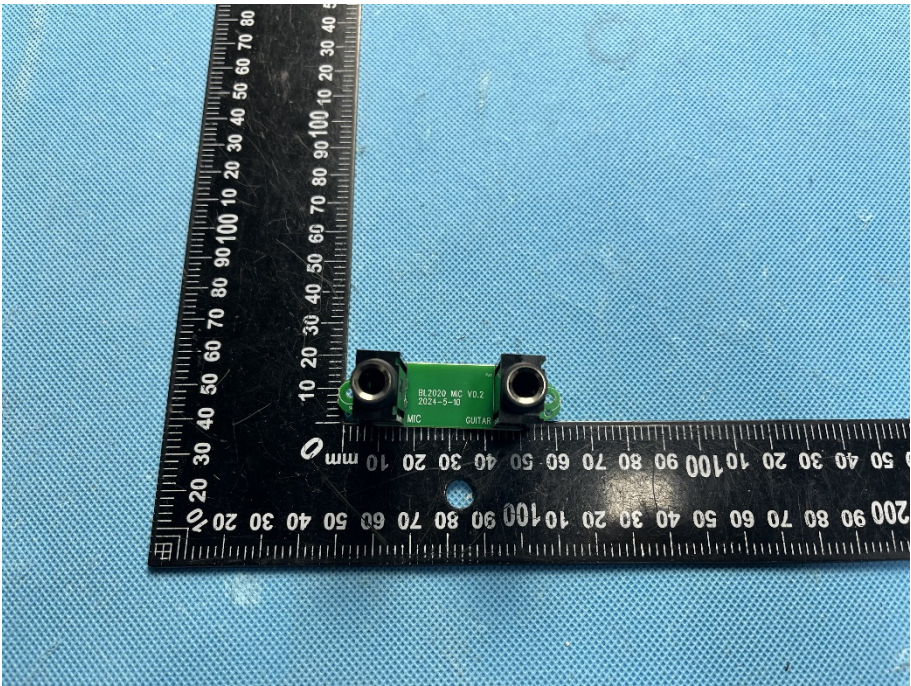

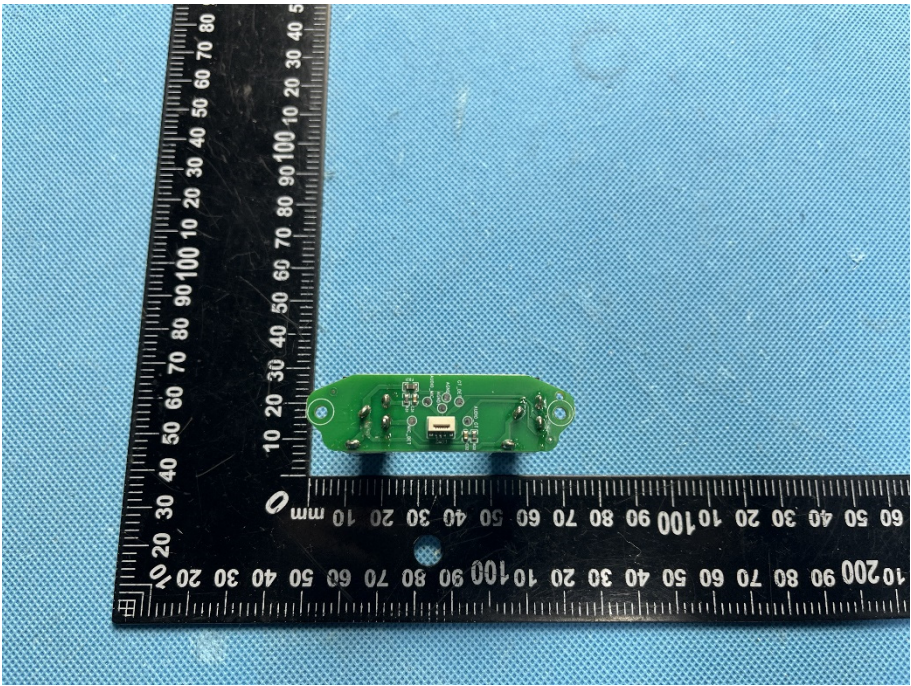
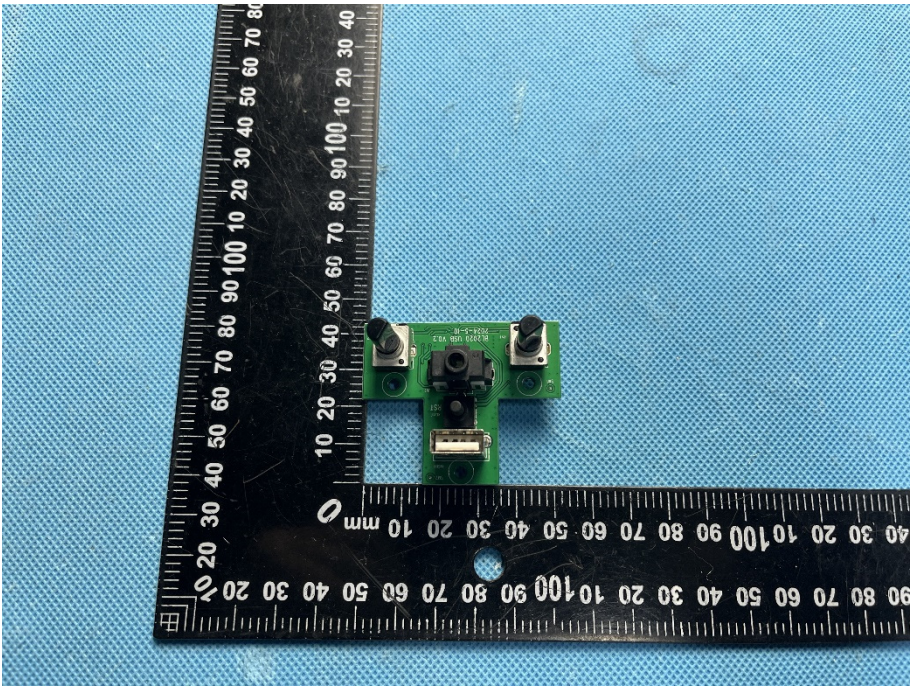

Board View 1**



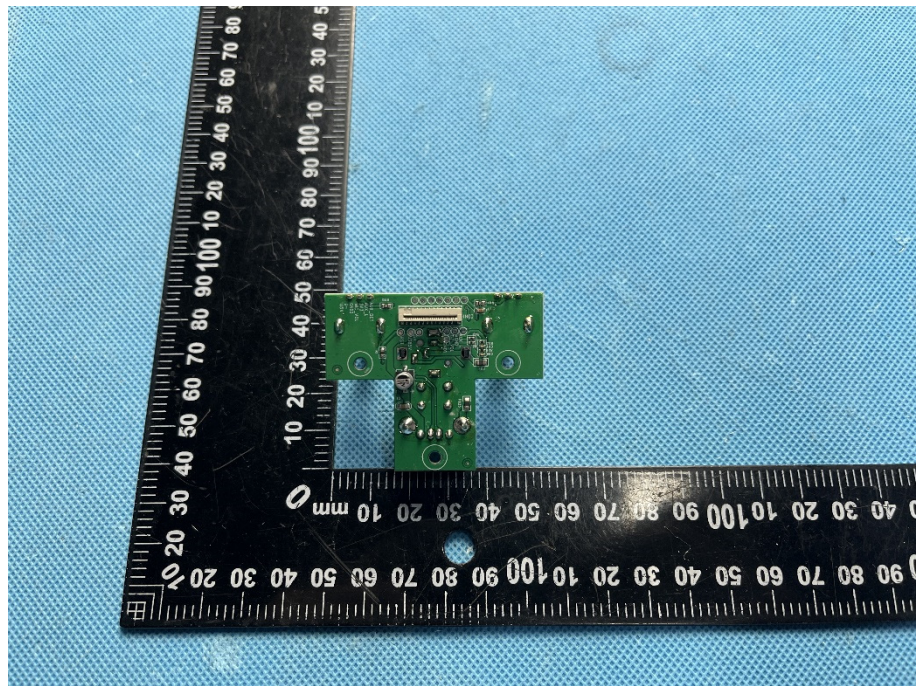

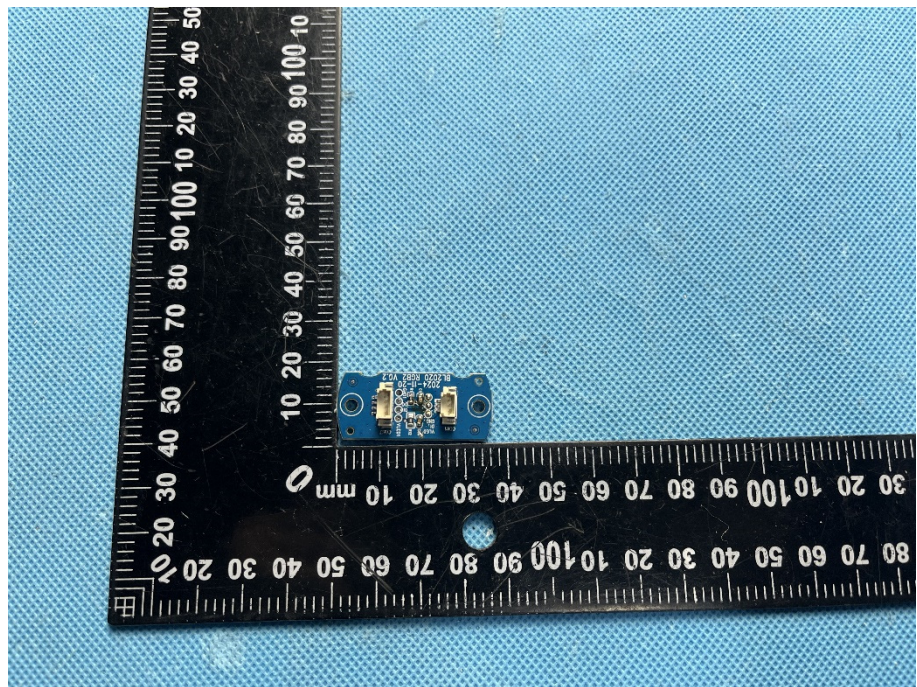

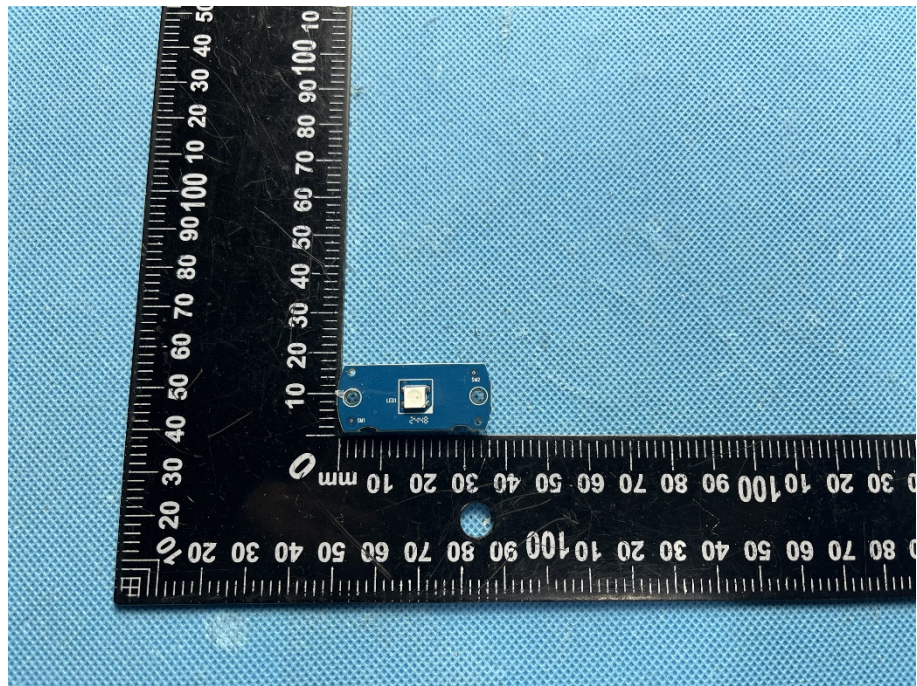
