

Safety precautions

- During charging, keep your laptop and adaptor near room temperature for efficient battery charging.
- · New batteries are not fully charged.
- New batteries or batteries stored for a long time may take more time to charge.
- The included adaptor is intended for indoor use only.
- Service should only be provided by an authorized service provider.
- Never attempt to disassemble, repair or modify the laptop yourself.
- Do not use the laptop in rain or other wet locations.
- Avoid spilling any liquid on the laptop.
- In case the laptop gets wet, unplug all cables and turn off the laptop.
- Do not attempt to dry the laptop with an external heat source.
- Unplug all cables and turn off the laptop before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the laptop and display.
- Avoid getting moisture in open ports.
- Do not use household cleaners, solvents, alcohol, or abrasives to clean the laptop.
- Routinely check the laptop for proper and safe conditions. If there is any damage, or broken parts, remove the laptop from use.
- If for any reason the screen (display) is fractured or cracked, immediately remove this product from use and contact Customer Support.
- It is rare but possible for seizures to be triggered by light flashes or patterns such as those on laptop or TV screens. To reduce exposure to this potential hazard, play/watch in a well-lit room, sit an appropriate distance from the screen and take 10 to 15-minute breaks every hour.
- Cords could be a strangulation hazard.
- Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age.
- Children pulling on the cord could cause the laptop or other equipment to which
 the device is connected to fall with possibility of property damage, serious injury,







1. Take out and identify the following items inside the box:




2. Using the provided screwdriver, secure the stand (base) to the stand (arm) with the 14mm screw.




3. Carefully place the All-In-One computer (AIO) screen facedown, and attach the assembled stand (**Step 2**) to the AIO.



4. Tilt the top of the arm mount bracket to fit inside the rectangular holes on the top and slowly push down until flush.




5. Using the provided screwdriver, attach the arm mount with two 8mm screws until tight.




Mounting holes are located at the bottom of the bracket as shown above.

NOTE: The tip of the provided screwdriver is magnetic to ease assembly by holding the screws in place while attaching.





6. Attaching the back panel (included)



Insert the flanges at the bottom first.


2 Snap the top into place.






Powering on/off

1. Complete the initial Windows setup by choosing your country/region, language, keyboard layout, and time zone.




2. Agree to Microsoft's legal terms.



3. Connect to your Wi-Fi network.




4. Select "Use Express settings" (recommended) found at the bottom right or select "Customize settings" (advanced users) found at the bottom left to finish your initial setup.

To use an app that requires a microphone or video input such as Cortana and Skype, you must connect a microphone or webcam.




The AIO has a total of 32GB of internal storage space, part of which is occupied with the Windows OS and preinstalled apps. To increase the system storage space, you can install a 2.5" SATA drive (not included) in the internal SATA drive bay accessible from the back of the AIO.




- 1. Take out and identify the following items inside the box:
 - Screwdriver
 - 1x SATA drive bracket
 - · 2x 5mm screws
 - 2x 4mm screws




2. Use a screwdriver to remove the screws securing the panel located on the back of the AIO.





3. Using the provided 5mm screws, secure the SATA drive bracket to a 2.5" SATA drive, and tighten the screws on each side.




4. Align the SATA drive on the guide rail and slide the SATA pins into the AlO's SATA connector until it is secure.



5. Use the provided 4mm screws to secure the SATA drive in place.




6. Put the panel back and tighten the screws.

2. Insert the wireless transmitter into the USB 2.0 port located at the bottom of the AIO.




For best performance, install the wireless USB transmitter utilizing the bottom USB 2.0 port and place the mouse and keyboard within the recommended 30' range.
