Dear Sir or Madam:

Sensormatic Electronics Corporation requests certain materials submitted with this application for certification of BVCACDRM-120K device be withheld from public disclosure. This request is made under the provision of 47 CFR 0.457 (d) and 5 USC 552(b)(4) Freedom of Information Act, Trade Secrets.

The items for which confidentiality is requested include the block diagram, schematic diagrams and printed circuit card photos. The information contains proprietary information (trade secrets) regarding the circuit operation and capabilities (specific values of components, circuit design details and system architecture) which are the result of our extensive investment in research and development. Without the disclosed information, competitive organizations would take considerable more time to assess and develop a workable competitive product. As a result, we believe that disclosure of these company-guarded materials would compromise our leading position in this market.

The equipment is installed and maintained by Sensormatic authorized and trained individuals. The circuitry is not directly viewable by the public or the users during use or after use.

We therefore formally request that the materials indicated "Confidential" be kept strictly confidential and not made available for inspections by any other party, except on a need to know basis for the sole purpose of the certification process.
