Charging

1. Insert the included charging cable's Micro USB end into the charging port on the case.

2. Insert the charging cable's standard USB end into the USB port of a computer or suitable wall adapter (not included).

3. The LED Charging Indicator Light will flash while the case is charging and will emit a steady light when fully charged.

1. Remove the earbuds from the case and they will turn on automatically.

4. Both earbud's LED Indicator will slowly flash blue once paired to your phone.

Using Your Earbuds: Music Controls

1. Press either earbud's Multi-Function button to pause and play music.

2. Press the left earbud's Multi-Function button two times to go back to the previous song.
Press 3 times to lower the volume.

3. Press the right earbud's Multi-Function button two times to go to the next song.
Press 3 times to raise the volume.

4. Press and hold either earbud's Multi-Function button for 2 seconds to activate Voice Assistant.

TWS Earbuds can be used independently. One earbud can be used when the other is off, as long as it is connected to Bluetooth.



2. Press and hold either earbud's Multi-function button for 2 seconds to reject an incoming call.
