

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging Instructions

The Rechargeable Audio Sleep Mask comes with built in rechargeable battery. Before using it for the first time you're recommended to charge the battery fully.

Plug the Type-C end of the included USB charging cable into the charging connection port of the unit. Plug the other end into a suitable USB port such as the one on your computer or other devices made for USB charging. The LED indicator turns red while charging. It takes about 1.5-2 hours for the unit to charge fully. When the battery is fully charged, the LED indicator will turn blue.

Turning on/off the unit

Long press the MF button to turn on/off the unit.

Pairing the unit with Bluetooth devices (phone or tablet that support call-answering)

Remark: The two built-in speakers are adjustable for all head sizes. Use your hands to adjust them to your desired locations.

Long press the MF button to turn on the unit, an indication tone will be heard and the LED flashes red and blue alternatively.

Place the unit and Bluetooth device (phone or tablet that support call answering) no further than 3 feet apart from each other.

Activate the Bluetooth function on your mobile device. Please refer to the manufacturer's instructions

for instructions on enabling Bluetooth on your device.

Once you have activated Bluetooth on your mobile device, select the "Nizoni Sleep Mask" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.

You might be prompted with "Pair with **Nizoni Sleep Mask**?" message on your source device, with "Cancel" and "OK" options. Please click "OK".

If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm & finalize pairing.

Once paired successfully, another indication tone will be heard, and the LED will turn off.

You can now start to use the unit.

If pairing is unsuccessful, turn off the device first and then re-pair following the above steps.

Once you have paired the unit with a mobile device, the unit will remember this mobile device and will pair automatically when its Bluetooth is activated within the range, during subsequent pairing. You do not need to re-pair any previously connected devices.

The unit will attempt to automatically connect to the last device it was paired with when switched on. If you want to pair it with a new device, please follow the steps outlined above.

Making a call with the unit in Bluetooth mode Basic operation

Function	Operation	Button
Answer incoming call	Incoming Call	Short press the MF button to answer an incoming call.
Reject Incoming Call	Incoming Call	Long press the MF button
End call	Incoming Call	After your phone conversation, short press the MF button
Increase Volume	During a call	Long press the volume increase button
Decrease Volume	During a call	Long press the volume decrease button
Redial last number	Standby mode and connected to a device	Short press the MF button twice

Listening to Music Wirelessly

Please ensure that your device (iPhone, Tablet or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the unit to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

Function	Operation	Button
Volume increase	Playing music	Long press the volume increase button
Volume decrease	Playing music	Long press the volume decrease button
Pause	Playing music	Short press the MF button will pause the music
Play	Pausing	Short press the MF button will resume the music

Next track	Playing music	Short press the next track button
Previous track	Playing music	Short press the previous track button

Note: An indication tone will alert you when the volume is set to maximum level.

Automatic Shutoff Timer Set:

- 1. Short press the volume increase button twice for the first time, voice prompt "one hour power off" would be heard, the unit would work for 1 hour then stop.
- 2. Short press the volume increase button twice the second time, voice prompt "two hours shutdown" would be heard, the unit would work for 2 hours then stop.
- 3. Short press the volume increase button the third time, voice prompt "long play" would be heard, the unit resumes to work continuously until low battery.

Voice Assistant Operation

Voice Assistant is a built-in interactive feature that allows you to Start Conversation with Your Siri or Google Assistant, with long press the MF button 1 second and release.

This feature enables you to ask questions and seek assistance on a number of things from your Voice Assistant, even when you're several feet away from your phone. Below are some of the many examples listed below.

Note: Google Assistant is available on eligible Android 5.0 devices or later. Works on Lollipop, Marshmallow and Nougat Android Phones with Google Play Services, >1.5GB of memory and 720P or higher screen resolution. Please ensure Google Assistant App is downloaded and made as default Voice Assistant on your mobile device.

While the unit is paired using Bluetooth, long press the MF button 1 second and release to start conversation with your Siri or Google Assistant. An indication tone may be heard before you speak into the unit.

- Example 1: Long press the MF button 1 second and release, then speak into the unit, how's the weather today?
 - Voice Assistant will reply with something like: mainly cloudy with a few showers.
- Example 2: Long press the MF button 1 second and release, then speak into the unit, what's the time now?
 - Voice Assistant will reply with something like: it is 8pm now.
- More examples:
 - Set an alarm for 7am tomorrow.
 - Play some music.
 - What's in the news?

Washing Instructions

Gently slip out the Bluetooth module, charging connection cable and speakers (that they are connected in 1 piece) from behind the face mask before washing. You may have to gently push the speaker with your finger to get it past the nose ridge area. Hand washing in warm water is recommended. Then, wait 4 to 6

hours for the sleep mask to dry out thoroughly before reinstalling back the Bluetooth module, charging connection cable and speakers inside the sleep mask.

Troubleshooting

Care and Maintenance

Read the following recommendations before using the unit. Following these you will be able to enjoy the product for many years.
