- 1) The wealth of information provided in reference to previous comment 8 (as given below) does not appear to contain the information requested. Kindly point to where this information may be found in the document provided, or provide a new exhibit as necessary.

It does not appear that a description of all circuitry and devices provided for determining and stabilizing frequency, for suppression of spurious radiation, for limiting modulation, and for limiting power was provided.

- 2) Is the information regarding previous comment 10 currently available?

FYI....This type of system in the PCS band appears unique. In these instances, the FCC typically has asked for a list of expected providers. If possible, please provide.
