
# Product introduction



# Power button

Short press: wake up the screen, lock the screen.

Long press:long press for 2-3 seconds in power off mode to switch on the device.

> Long press for 2-3 seconds in normal operation mode to select power off or reboot.

Long press for 11 seconds when system is frozenfor automatic reboot.

#### Volume button

Volume adjustment (with app support, the button can be set as quick code scan button).

#### Printer

For printing sales slips in power on mode.

Return button

Tap to return to the previous screen.

#### Home button

Tap to guickly view the background programs;

Select the app and slide laterally to close.

Magnetic card reader


For reading the magnetic stripe information of bank cards.

#### IC-card reader

For inserting chip-based bank cards

#### NFC reader

For reading Quick Pass bank cards



# Indicator light

For bank card payment steps reminder.

#### MICRO USB interface

For device recharging and developer debugging.

#### Camera

Only for QR code scanning.

### Flashlight

For lighting in camera mode.

# PSAM card slot

For inserting encrypted PSAM CPU cards.

Note: To prevent system errors, please make sure the device is turned off when you insert or remove the SIM card.

- · Move SIM card cover horizontally to open;
- · Insert/remove SIM card in the direction as shown:
- · Fasten the battery cover horizontally.


# Batterv

Avoid contact with water, metal objects and other electrically charged equipment while in use.

For fixing handheld strap to prevent slippage.

### Printing instructions

This device supports 58mm thermal paper with the specifications of  $57\pm0.5\text{mm}*\emptyset40\text{mm}$ 

- · Please open the paper container with the uncovering handle (as shown in Fig.1). Please do not force open the paper container to avoid print head gear wear;
- · Feed the paper correctly into the paper container in the direction as shown, and pull some paper outside the cutter (as shown in Fig.2);
- · Close the cover of the paper container to finish printing paper feeding (as shown in Fig.3).

Note: If the printed paper is blank, please check whether the paper roll has been installed in the correct direction.


# Simplified settings

A few steps for starting the smart business device

- 1)2G/3G settings: insert the corresponding 2G (GSM)/3G (GSM) card in power off mode and reboot your device. (For more details about supported cards, please read the technical specifications)
- 2Press the power button for 2-3 seconds to wake up the screen,enter the initial boot interface, and follow the prompts. This device offers two network patterns.
- **3WIFI** settings
- · Tap [Settings] button and turn on WLAN to enter WLAN search interface, and wait until it finds and lists the availableWLAN
- ·Tap the WLAN that you want to connect you need to enterthe access code if you choose an encrypted network.

# Instructions for recharging and battery

This device supports charging only by USB cable

- · Connect the 5V adapter to the power supply socket;
- · Connect the USB cable to the USB interface of the device for recharging:
- · The screen will display the recharging icon during the recharging process;
- · If the recharging icon does not appear, please check whether the USB interface is well connected.

#### Instructions/Notes for battery

- · This device adopts 3.7V/5200mAh lithium battery; please do not disassemble the battery.
- · In order to protect the battery life, we recommend that you recharge the device whenever possible, and please do not allow the battery to fully drain before recharging.

# Trouble shooting

#### Printer not working

- · Make sure the cover of the paper container is properly closed:
- · Make sure the right printing paper is used and properly fed;
- · Check whether 58mm\*40mm thermal paper roll is fed into the paper container;
- · Note: If the printed paper is blank, please check whether the paper roll has been installed in the correct direction.

# The device cannot be switched on (e.g. exhausted battery)

- · Connect the device properly with a USB cable to recharge for
- · Check whether the screen is displaying recharging status.

# What to do if the system freezes

Press the power button for 11 seconds to reboot.


