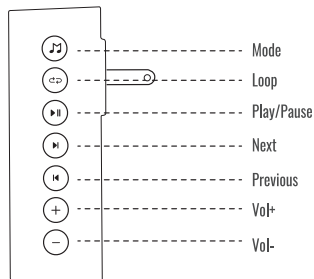

Power on: Plug the unit into a standard socket and turn on the switch.

How to use:

- Mode: Move from one mode to another
- Loop: Play the same song on repeat. To turn off loop: press this button again
- Play/Pause: Play/Pause the song
- Next/Previous: Move one song forward/backward
- Volume control: Increase/Decrease playback volume

Auto-Off timer:

The unit powers off after the set time duration. To listen again, turn off / on the switch button.

Timer can be set for 15 mins, 30 mins, 60 mins or OFF.

To set the timer or turn off the set timer, press the 'Play/Pause' button for 2-3 seconds.

To choose a preferred time duration / OFF, repeat this process.

WARRANTY TERMS

Warranty is provided only on Product(s) which is purchased from Saregama, Saregama Authorized Dealer, Authorized Reseller or Authorized Online Resellers.

The Customer will receive as reply to his/ her email an address on which said Customer may send the defective unit of the Product ("said address").
