5. DECISION RULES AND MEASUREMENT UNCERTAINTY

5.1. METROLOGICAL TRACEABILITY

All test and measuring equipment utilized to perform the tests documented in this report are calibrated on a regular basis, with a maximum time between calibrations of one year or the manufacturers' recommendation, whichever is less, and where applicable is traceable to recognized national standards.

5.2. DECISION RULES

6.4. SOFTWARE AND FIRMWARE

The EUT firmware installed during testing was 0.81 for the radiated sample and 0.293 for the conducted sample

6.5. WORST-CASE CONFIGURATION AND MODE

Radiated emissions below 1GHz, above 18GHz, and power line conducted emission were performed with the EUT set to transmit at the channel with highest PSD as worst-case scenario. This was found to be a data rate of 500 Kbps at 2440 MHz for chain 0, and 125 Kbps at 2440 MHz for chain 1.

Band edge and radiated emissions between 1GHz and 18GHz were performed with the EUT set to transmit at the highest power on low and high channels, as well as mid channel for radiated emissions. Bandedge was ran at both 2 Mbps and 500 Kbps as worst case for Chain 0 and 2 Mbps and 125 Kbps for Chain 1 as worst-case based on average output power. Harmonics was run only on 500 Kbps for Chain 0 and 125 Kbps for Chain 1 as worst-case based on PSD.

The fundamental of the EUT was investigated in three orthogonal orientations X,Y,Z, it was determined that the X orientation was worst-case orientation for both antennas. Therefore, all final radiated testing was performed with the EUT in the X orientation.

Data rates as provided by the client were 125 Kbps, 500 Kbps, 1 Mbps, and 2 Mbps.

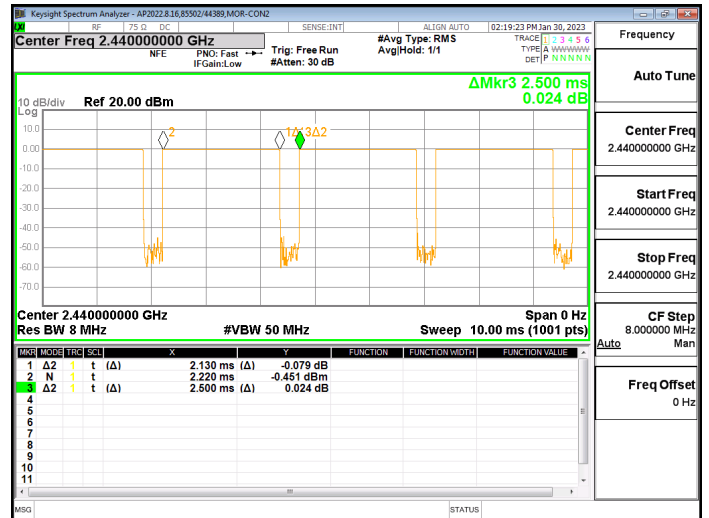

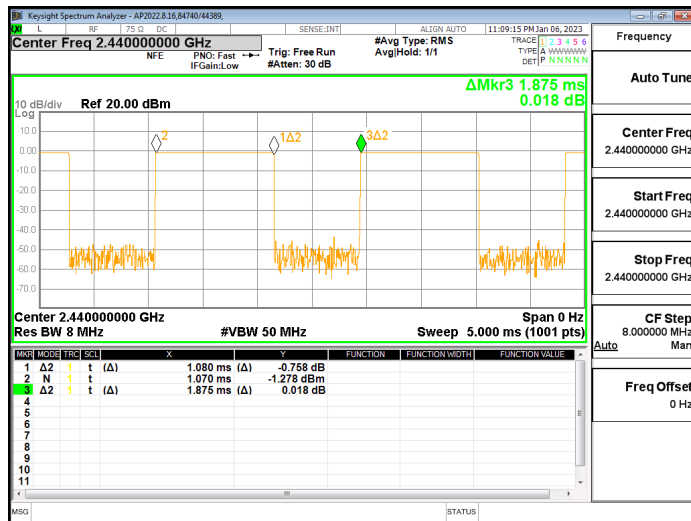

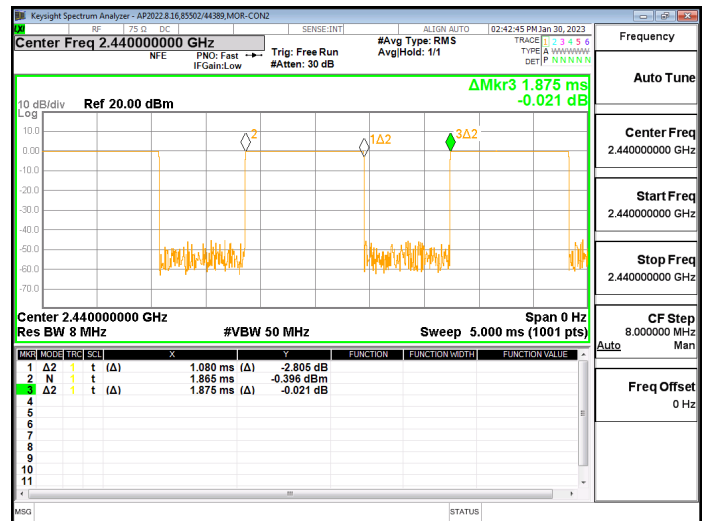
DUTY CYCLE BLE – 1Mbps CHAIN 0



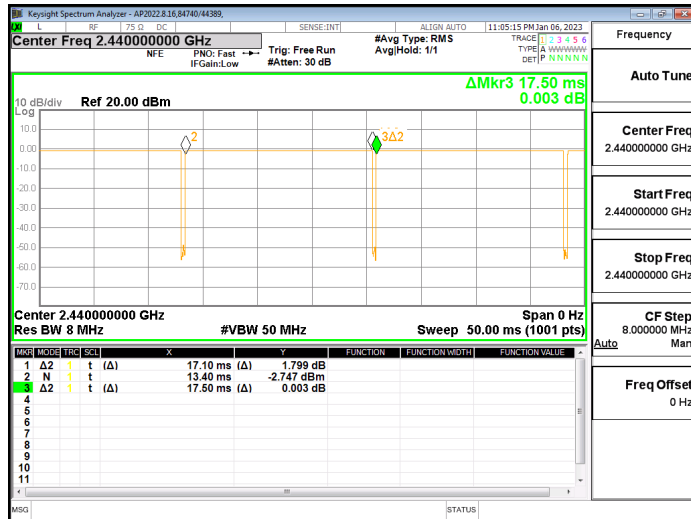
DUTY CYCLE BLE – 1Mbps CHAIN 1



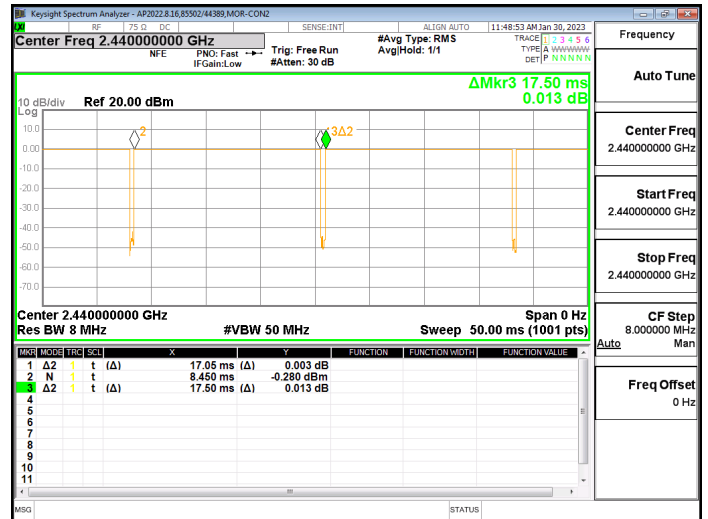
DUTY CYCLE BLE – 2Mbps CHAIN 0



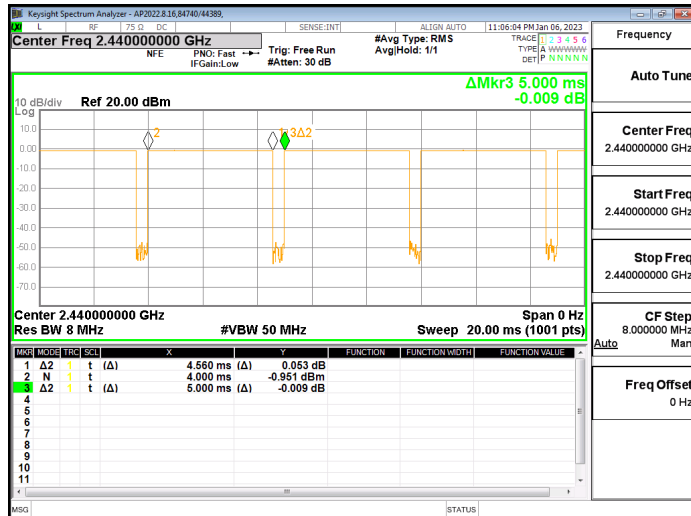

The maximum antenna gain is less than or equal to 6 dBi, therefore the limit is 30 dBm.

TEST PROCEDURE

The transmitter output is connected to a power meter.

The cable assembly insertion loss of 11.33 dB (including 9.68 dB pad and 0.35 dB cable) was entered as an offset in the power meter to allow for a peak reading of power.

The power output was measured on the EUT antenna port using SMA cable with 10dB attenuator connected to a power meter via wideband power sensor. Peak output power was read directly from power meter.

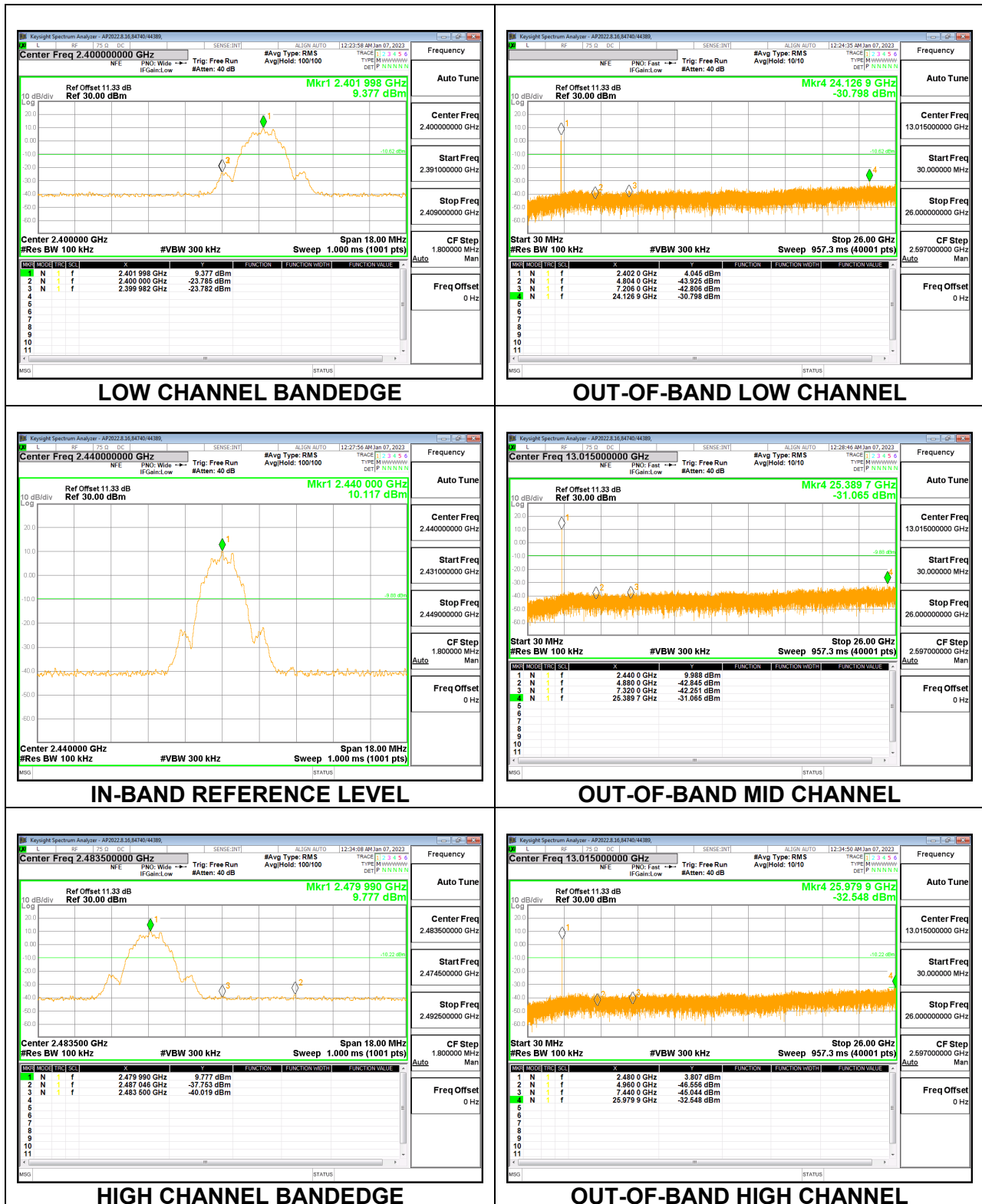
