

III. MODE operation

1. Music mode

⇒ Push the •/M button and then press the ◆ button to confirm in the Music mode.

2. Tuner mode


⇒ Push the •/M button and then press the ▶ button to confirm in the Tuner mode.

3. Voice mode

⇒ Push the •/M button and then press the + button to confirm in the Voice mode.

4. Line-in mode


 \Rightarrow Push the \bullet/M button and then press the - button to confirm in the line-in mode.




IV. MENU

- 1. Press and hold the **1** button to display the menu system.
- 2. It is composed of 4 main menu with sub-menus.
- 3. When you select a sub-menu, you can set your preference to be displayed.
- 4. Press the ◀ or ▶ button to move between main menu and sub-menu.
- 5. To press the +,-, ♥ . ▶ button, adjust of each other function.
- 6. Press the **1** button in final sub-menu, it is setting and move to previous menu.


[System Mode]



[Display Mode]




[Sound Mode]

1. To pause voice recording or again to restart recording, press the •/► button during recording.




V. Operating the TUNER

- 1. To select tuner of record mode in the menu.
- 2. To change frequency, push the

 or

 button to the left or right.
- 3. To select the stereo or mono, press the •/▶ button.
- 4. To select preset function, press the N button.
- To search memory channel, press the A-B button.(It only activates while the player is not in preset mode.)
- 6. Memory delete function: select the station to be deleted at preset mode and then press and hold the A-B button.
- 7. To record FM, press the •/M button during FM reception.
- 8. To stop FM recording, press the •/M button.
 - (* Note: Auto memory may not work within weak transmission areas.)



VI. Recording VOICE

- 1. To select voice of record mode in the menu.
- 2. To recording voice, press the •/M button.
- 3. To stop recording, press the •/M button.
- 4. To play a recorded file, press the •/▶ button.
- 5. To pause voice recording, press the •/▶ button during recording.
- 6. Press the •/▶ button again to restart recording.
 - (* Note: Volume can not be controlled while recording.)



* Press the ■/► button to go to voice recording mode

* Press the •/M button and voice recording starts.

VII. LINE-IN Function

- 1. Recording from the external audio source, connect line out jack of the external equipment to line in jack of the MP3 player.
- 2. To select line in of record mode in the menu.
- 3. To stop recording, press the •/M button.
- 4. To play a recorded file, press the •/▶ button.



* Press the •/• button to go to line in recording mode. In this case, record standby mode.

* Press the •/M button and recording is started.
