



Charging the battery for first time

(not included) using the included USB cable. 2.) The CHARGER indicator will light red while charging and light green when the unit is fully charged. Unplug the USB cable from the power source once the battery is fully charged.



Bluetooth operation

External devices that have a built-in Bluetooth feature can connect wirelessly to the Blue Speaker

GETTING CONNECTED

- Power on the unit by press the POWER button, WORKING MODE indicator will light blue 1 and flach
- 2. Set the Bluetooth function of your external device to ON and begin searching for devices NOTE: The effective distance between your external device and this apparatus is 10 meters(30 feet).
- 3. Once "Pro PSP1705" appears on the paired device list of your external device, select it. 4. If you are asked for a password, enter "0000".
- A Bluetooth connected message will be heard and WORKING MODE indicator light blue 5. steadily that indicates a connection has been established.
- 6 A few seconds later your Bluetooth connection should be ready to used

PLAYING MUSIC FROM AN EXTERNAL BLUETOOTH DEVICE

- Follow the "GETTING CONNECTED" steps above to pair your external device. 1 2. Turn on the music player program on your external device and set it to play. Normally, you can control music playback with the ₱ /PAIR, ₩ and ₱ buttons on the Bluetooth Speaker.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth Device will now be heard through the 3. speakers.
- 4. Adjust the VOLUME knob to obtain the desired volume level
- 5. Press POWER button to turn off the unit.

LED light up operation

This device is built-in random color LED light up function for the speakers.

Press POWER switch to turn the unit ON and then press the LIGHT button to turn on/off the LED light for the speakers

Radio operation

This device is built-in FM radio function.


- 1. Press POWER switch to turn the unit ON and then press SOURCE button twice to select the FM radio mode. SOLIRCE Button sequence - Bluetooth -> ALIX -> EM Radio
- 2. Under the FM radio mode, press the PLAY button in 3 seconds to start AUTO SCAN all available FM radio mode, press the PLAY button in 3 seconds to start AUTO SCAN all available FM radio stations.
 3. Press the Previous/Forward button for tuning the previous or next scanned radio
- stations.

Auxiliary operation

External (auxiliary) audio sources such as tablets smartphones or MP3 players can connect to the Bluetooth Light up Speaker via aux-in.

- 2 Set the volume to the minimum level with the VOLUME knob.
- Plug in an AUX IN cable into the AUX IN jack on the top of the unit 3. 4.
- Plug the other end of the cable into the headphone or Line-Out jack of the external source. 5. Turn on the external audio device and set it to play. Turn the external audio device's volume up to 2/3.If necessary, adjust the volume on the main unit by turning the VOLUME knob.
