Dear Sandy Mazzola:

As per my discussions with our engineering team, I am writing to you regarding FCC certification of Symbol products into which Sierra Wireless OEM modules are integrated.

I hereby grant formal approval to Symbol Technologies to file a Class II permissive change with the FCC, using Sierra Wireless' FCC ID. This approval is conditional on the following:

1. Sierra Wireless' FCC ID may only be used in products within which the SB300 or SB320 OEM Module is the only RF element included in that product. If additional RF elements (other radios, for example) are used, Symbol must apply for and use their own FCC ID.
2. Symbol provides Sierra Wireless with a copy of all detailed SAR and ERP test results, FCC grant documentation, and a copy their FCC label for both the initial configuration and for any subsequent changes made to Symbols products that may affect radiated emissions. This documentation must be provided before the product in question has been released for sale.

I should also point out that Symbol may choose to file for their own FCC ID, and that Sierra Wireless retains the right to withdraw the above permission if Symbol fails to satisfy FCC requirements. If you have any further questions, please contact me. All relevant documentation should be sent to Sierra Wireless, care of myself.
