



- Power on: Press and hold the "MFB" button 3 seconds and the blue indicator light flashes 3 times Power off: Press and hold the "MFB" button 3.5 seconds the red indicator light flashes once
- Answering a call: Short press "MFB" button
- Ending a call: Short press the "MFB" button
- Rejecting a call: Press the "V-" button 2 seconds
- Redialing the last called number: Double press the "MFB" button when headset is in standby mode
- Voice dialing: With the headset in standby mode, long press the "MFB" 1 second and release (Your phone must support this function)
- Play / Pause: Short press the "MFB" button to play and pause when headset is in standby mode
- Previous / Next Track: Press the "V-" 1 second to previous track, press the "V+" 1 second to next track
- Volume control: Short press the "V+" or "V-" to control the volume
