


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#### 2.2 BLOCK DIGRAM SHOWING THE CONFIGURATION OF SYSTEM TESTED

## 8.2 TEST PROCEDURE

- a. The measuring distance of at 3 m shall be used for measurements at frequency 0.009MHz up to 1GHz,and above 1GHz.
- b. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters (above 1GHz is 1.5 m) above the ground at a 3 meter anechoic chamber test site. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- c. The height of the equipment shall be 0.8 m(above 1GHz is 1.5 m); the height of the test antenna shall vary between 1 m to 4 m. horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. The initial step in collecting conducted emission data is a spectrum analyzer peak detector mode pre-scanning the measurement frequency range. Significant peaks are then marked and then QuasiPeak detector mode re-measured.
- e. If the Peak Mode measured value compliance with and lower than Quasi Peak Mode Limit, the EUT shall be deemed to meet QP Limits and then no additional QP Mode measurement performed.






(A) Radiated Emission Test-Up Frequency Below 30MHz





#### **10. ANTENNA REQUIREMENT**

#### **10.1 STANDARD REQUIREMENT**

For intentional device, according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device. And according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.247 (b), if transmitting antennas of directional gain greater than 6dBi are used, the power shall be reduced by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.

#### 10.2 RESULT

The antennas used for this product are PCB and no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device, the maximum peak gain of the transmit antenna is -4.40 dBi.
