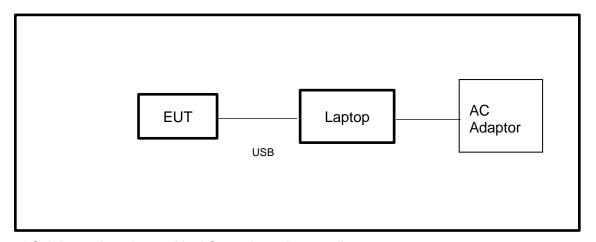

TEST PROCEDURE
