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Gentlemen:

This letter is supplemental to the previous cover letter dated March 2, 2004, in which we requested a Limited Modular Approval (LMA) of the Intel Mini PCI Type 802.11BG for use in the Hewlett Packard platforms HSTNN-I01C (Crystal), PP2090 (Diamond), and PP2190 (Ruby) Laptops.

We hereby request that this approval be changed to a system approval, and that the grant notes be changed to be worded as follows:

Output power is Conducted. The Mini-PCI Card is to be installed in the specific notebook computers shown in this filing only by the grantee or their designated OEM integrator - user installation is prohibited. Installation of this device into other host products requires the submission of a Class II permissive change application containing data demonstrating compliance for spurious emissions, or new application if appropriate. Compliance of this device in all final host configurations is the responsibility of the Grantee. Co-located transmitter operating conditions have been evaluated as described in this filing. The antenna(s) used for this transmitter must not be co-located or operate in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter other than the configurations evaluated as described in this filing. Only the antennas documented in this filing, installed in the manner specified, and at a distance of at least 20cm from all persons can be used with this device. End-users must be provided with operating instructions for satisfying RF exposure compliance requirements.
