



POWER SOURCE:

The unit has built-in Li-ion rechargeable battery; recharge it before use or when battit is drained as follows:

- Open the rubber cover on the Micro USB Port.
- 2. Connect the Micro USB Plug from the supplied connection cable to the Micro USB Port.
- Connect the full sized USB Plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB Port on the Computer or USB Charger. (Computer and USB Charger NOT supplied).
- When charging, the Red Charging Indicator around the Button will illuminate.
 When charging is complete, it will turn off.
- Disconnect the cable from the unit. Closed the Rubber Cover completely. (This cover is to ensure water and dusts protection; always make sure it is completely closed)

Notes:

Your battery will last longer if you follow these simple guidelines for caring and storing:

- A. Before first time use, charge it approximately 4 hours until the unit is fully charged.
- B. Recharge and store the unit within the temperature range of 5°C~35°C (40°F~95°F).
- C. Do not overcharge (longer than 24 hours). Excessive charging or running the unit until completely flat will damage battery. Battery life will be extended if you keep the battery fully charged.
- D. Battery life naturally shortens slowly over time.
- E. The rechargeable battery incorporated in this product is not user replaceable.

OPERATION:

BT (Bluetooth) Pairing:

First time you use the unit or pair it to a new Bluetooth Device, pair it as follows:

- Power on the unit by sliding the Power ON/OFF Switch to ON position. The Blue and Red Indicators around the Button will illuminate and blink. The unit will vibrate briefly.
- Power on the external BT Device and enter the BT search mode. Start pairing following on the screen instructions from the external BT Device. After pairing:
 - The Blue Indicator will stop blinking.
 - The Red Indicator will go out.
 - The unit will vibrate briefly.
- 3. Plays the music in the paired BT Device as usual.
- 4. During playback:
 - Press the + or Buttons on the unit to adjust volume level as desire.
 - Press the II Button to pause: press again to resume normal playback.
 - Press the or Buttons to skip tracks.
 - Press and holding the or Buttons to fast search.
- 5. If the unit is paired to a Cell Phone and a call is received while listening to music, press and release the Button to pause the music playback then use the built-in Microphone to answer the call. When your call is complete, press and releases the Button to resume music playback.

When finished listening, slide the Power ON/OFF Switch to OFF position to shut off the unit. Place the Earbuds to the magnetic holder as illustrated below:



Notes:

- When the external Bluetooth Device searched the unit, our model number "MBH513" will appear on the display of external Bluetooth Device.
- Pairing code "0000" or "1234" may need to enter.

Normal Operation After Pairing:

- Power on the unit by sliding the Power ON/OFF Switch to ON position. The Blue and Red Indicators around the Button will illuminate and blink. The unit will vibrate briefly.
- 2. Power on the external BT Device and enter to BT mode.
- 3. Wait a few seconds until the unit auto pairs to the external BT Device. Then:
 - The Blue Indicator will stop blinking.
 - The Red Indicator will not light.
 - The unit will vibrate briefly.
- 4. Plays music in the paired BT Device as usual.
