







(1.1) Unbox

- a. Carefully unbox Sactionals Inserts, Covers, and all StealthTech products.
- b. Remove Cushions, Back Pillows, and Hardware from Inserts.



(1.2) Review labels and markings

- a. Take note of your Cover fabric type and color, which will be used later when creating your tuning profile in the Lovesac StealthTech App. This information can be found on your packing slip or on the label located inside your Covers (2021 Covers or newer).
- **b.** Note Right and Left Sound + Charge Sides are labeled "R" and "L", and Satellite Sides are labeled "S" for easy identification.
- c. Note position of Integrated Wireless Charger so that, after covering your Sides, you can place your phone correctly.




Step 2 Cover Inserts and Recycle Cardboard Boxes



Cover Inserts and Install Feet

a. Cover all Sactionals Inserts, including Sound + Charge Sides and any Satellite Sides.

- StealthTech Sides use Standard Sactionals Covers.
- More detailed covering instructions are available on Sactionals Insert box flaps.
- Do not install Feet on Seat Frame that the Subwoofer will be installed into.




*Note: Mounting your Center Channel can be done at any time.

- a. Using a level, tape the wall-mount paper guide to the wall centered below the TV.
- **b.** Mark screw locations.
 - Stud mounted (Recommended):
 - 1. Use a stud finder to determine if the wall-mount bracket can be stud mounted.
 - 2. Using the template, identify the 2 top row slots that align with the studs. Mark the screw locations through the paper onto the wall.
 - Drywall mounted:
 - 1. Mark screw locations for the 4 outer slots through the paper onto the wall.
- c. Remove paper guide.



Step 3 Install Sound + Charge Center Channel (Continued)


- (3.3) Wall-Mount Option: Attach Bracket
 - a. Remove and discard both foam protectors from Center Channel Wall-Mount Bracket posts.
 - **b.** Attach Center Channel Wall-Mount Bracket:
 - Stud mounted:
 - 1. Attach bracket using a drill and included bit with the 2 longer stud screws.
 - Drywall mounted:
 - 1. Insert 4 drywall anchors with a drill.
 - 2. Attach bracket by inserting the 4 shorter drywall screws into the anchors.



(3.4) Wall-Mount Option: Mount Center Channel

- a. Push Center Channel onto Center Channel bracket with keyholes aligned to posts.
- **b.** Firmly press down to lock in place.

Paution: Ensure keyholes are oriented as shown to prevent Center Channel from falling.




Step 4 Connect Sound + Charge Center Channel to TV

*Note: Some TVs require settings changes to be compatible with external speakers. Consult your TV manual.

(4.1) Input Connection Option 1: HDMI ARC

a. Connect included HDMI cable to **HDMI ARC** ports on your Center Channel and TV. If HDMI ARC port is not labeled, consult your TV manual.


*Note: With newer TV models, you must turn eARC off in your TV settings.



(4.2) Input Connection Option 2: Optical

a. Connect included Optical cable to Optical ports on your Center Channel and TV.


*Note: It is recommended that you turn the TV speakers off in your TV settings. Also, the TV remote will not change your system volume when using Optical.



Step 5 Power Sound + Charge Center Channel On




a. Plug Center Channel power cord into an outlet.




(5.2) Power On and Select Input

- a. If Center Channel is off, press Power button.
- **b.** Select input by pressing the **Input** button on the Center Channel.



(5.3) Pair Remote Control

- **a.** With Center Channel on, simultaneously hold down the **Volume +** and **-** buttons on the Remote Control for more than 5 seconds.
 - Red LED on Remote Control will blink for two seconds, then turn off.
- **b.** Change volume with Remote Control to verify successful pairing.



6.1 Attach Brackets


- a. With speaker facing up, align brackets as shown below.
- **b.** Use included thumb screws to secure brackets.



(6.2) Mount Subwoofer to Seat Frame

- a. Place Seat Frame upside down.
- **b.** With speaker facing up, align Subwoofer Mounting Brackets with Feet holes.
 - Subwoofer speaker will face the floor once fully installed into your configuration.
- c. Install 4 Feet through the mounting bracket holes.

*Note: Subwoofers are not intended to be installed in Sactionals Storage Seats.




Partially thread all four Feet before fully tightening them down. Do not over tighten.

Step 7 Connect Audio and Power Cables to Subwoofer(s)


*Note: Left/Right positions are determined when seated on your Sactionals facing the TV.

- (7.1) Connect Audio Cables and Power Cord
 - a. Connect both R and L Sound + Charge Side Audio Cables to the Subwoofer.
 - b. If purchased, connect Satellite Side Audio Cable(s) to the S(LEFT) or S(RIGHT) ports.
 - c. Connect AC cord to power adaptor, then insert power cord into Subwoofer.

*Note: Large setups may require one or more 25ft Audio Cables. See page 7.



- (7.2) Optional: Connect Satellite Subwoofer Audio Cable and Power Cord
 - **a.** If purchased, connect provided Auxiliary Cable to "Out" on one Subwoofer and to "In" on the next Satellite Subwoofer.
 - **b.** Connect AC cord to power adaptor, then insert power cord into Satellite Subwoofer.



- **b.** A "water-drop" tone will play and Subwoofer LED will turn off when pairing is successful.

 - Option 2: Remote Control
 - 1. Press and hold Bluetooth button for 3 seconds to initiate Bluetooth pairing process.
- c. Center Channel enters pairing mode when front LEDs begin to flash.
- d. Connect to Center Channel.
 - **1.** Open the Bluetooth settings on your smart device and select "**StealthTech**" to connect. Play music through your favorite music service.



*Note: Performing operations in Step 13.1b will disconnect any connected device and put the Center Channel into pairing mode for another device to be connected.

Step 14 Download the Lovesac StealthTech App



(14.1) Download the Lovesac StealthTech App

- a. Download the "Lovesac StealthTech" App from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
 - Requires Android Version 10 or newer, or Apple iOS 13 or newer.
- b. Ensure Center Channel and Subwoofer are powered on.
- **c.** Follow the in-app instructions to finish setting up your custom tuning profile based on your configuration shape and fabric type.

Additional App Features:

- Toggle between Harman Kardon defined presets (see page 31).
- Create and save custom presets (see page 31).
- Adjust treble, bass, speaker balance, center channel volume, and system volume.





*Notes:

- The app can be downloaded to multiple devices, but only one can have the app open and actively control the System at a time.
- Separate Bluetooth connections are required to use the app and to stream music from your device. The app automatically connects to the System when the app is open. To stream music from your device, follow the Bluetooth pairing process on page 29.

Product Overview

Sound + Charge Center Channel

The Sound + Charge Center Channel decodes the incoming audio signal then transmits that signal to the Sound + Charge Subwoofer. It also acts as the Center Channel speaker with 4 mid range speakers, 1 tweeter, and 2 mini subwoofers. The Center Channel automatically switches to standby after 10 minutes of inactivity. The Center Channel can power on automatically with either HDMI ARC or Bluetooth inputs, *if* the respective input was active when the Center Channel was powered off.






- 1. HDMI ARC: Connect to the HDMI ARC port on your TV.
- **2. Optical In:** Connect to an optical audio output on your TV or digital device.
- 3. AUX In: Connect to an audio device (3.5 mm cable).
- 4. Factory USB port: For factory service only.

Troubleshooting

Issue 1: No sound coming from any speakers

- Ensure Center Channel is powered on.
- Ensure Center Channel power cord is securely connected.
- Plug a different device into the electrical outlet to verify that the outlet is working correctly.
- Ensure mute is off and volume is not set to zero.
- Ensure correct source is selected.
- Ensure source cord is plugged in.
 - If using HDMI ARC, ensure it is connected to the correct HDMI port on the TV.
 - If problem persists, try another source or different audio content.
- Check TV settings for audio output. Sometimes it may be sending audio through optical when you are connected to HDMI or vice versa.
- If using Bluetooth, ensure that the volume on your source device is turned up and that the device is not muted.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 2: No sound coming from Center Channel only

- Ensure Center Volume is not turned down all the way
- If the audio source is 5.1, sometimes the recorded audio does not provide content on all channels.
 - To check this: Try another source or different audio content to see if problem persists.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 3: No sound coming from Subwoofer and Sides (couch)

- Ensure Subwoofer is plugged in and powered on.
- · Check EQ settings:
 - If Quiet Couch Mode is on and volume set very low, little sound will come from couch.
 - On the News setting, no sound comes from couch speakers and very little comes from the Subwoofer.
- Try another source or different audio content to see if problem persists.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 4: No sound coming from Subwoofer (but sound is coming from other couch speakers)

- Check EQ settings:
 - If Quiet Couch Mode is on and volume set very low, little sound will come from Subwoofer.
 - If the News preset is selected and volume set very low, little sound will come from the Subwoofer.
 - If the Bass is turned low and volume set very low, little sound will come from Subwoofer.
- Switch to audio with known bass content.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 5: No sound coming from one or more Sides

- Ensure the Side(s) is plugged in (check both ends of each cable).
- Check EQ settings:
 - If Quiet Couch Mode is on and volume set very low, little sound will come from Side(s).
 - If the News preset is selected and volume set very low, little sound will come from Side(s).
- Try another source or different audio content to see if problem persists.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 6: Distorted sound, poor audio, or echo in the system

- Check if the TV is playing audio through TV speakers and StealthTech System.
 - Press Mute button on TV.
 - TV settings may require you to select output "speaker".
- For Bluetooth, ensure the device is within connection range.
 - Move the device closer to the Center Channel, or remove any obstacle between the device and the Center Channel.
- Check all cable connections throughout system.
- Try another source or different audio content to see if problem persists.
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 7: Bluetooth cannot pair or connect to

• Check if Center Channel is in Bluetooth pairing mode (see page 29).

Help & Troubleshooting

- Check if system is connected to another device.
 - Disconnect other device or press and hold Bluetooth button on remote control.
- Ensure the device is within connection range.
 - Move the device closer to the Center Channel, or remove any obstacle between the device and the Center Channel.
- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on device.
- Try connecting another device to see if problem persists.
- Go to the list of connected Bluetooth devices on your phone, make your phone "forget" StealthTech, and re-pair.
- Unplug Center Channel for 10 seconds and plug back in.
- Note that separate Bluetooth connections are required to use the app and to stream music from your device (see *Notes on page 30).
- After checking all other options, factory reset system and re-pair (see page 42).

Issue 8: App not connecting to the system

- Ensure the app is closed on other devices.
- See Issue 7 to verify the phone is properly connected to the system.
- Verify Android or IOS version supports the app.
 The app requires Android Version 10 or newer, or Apple iOS 13 or newer.

Issue 9: Remote Control doesn't work

- Ensure batteries are good.
- Ensure the remote is paired to the system.
 - Re-pair the remote (see page 42).

Issue 10: Integrated Wireless Charger not working

- Ensure the Side is plugged in (check if sound is coming from speakers).
- Ensure the device is positioned correctly over the charging mark.
 - Remove cover to see charging mark and learn positioning.
 - Note that not all phones have charging coils centered in the phone.
- Ensure the phone has wireless charging capabilities.
 - For example, iPhone 7 or older does not.

System Reset and Update

How to perform factory reset of Center Channel

- 1. Power on Center Channel.
- 2. Hold down Center Channel + and buttons simultaneously for 10 seconds.
- 3. All LEDs turn will turn off, turn on, and turn off.
 - * Subwoofer and Remote Control will both need to be paired to the Center Channel again (see steps below).

Pair Subwoofer and Center Channel

- 1. With the Center Channel and Subwoofer powered on, hold the **Input** and + buttons on the Center Channel simultaneously for 3 seconds to enable pairing. Release buttons when the Center Channel front LED starts to flash.
- **2.** A "water-drop" tone will play when pairing is successful. All LEDs will turn off.
- **3.** If pairing is unsuccessful, unplug the Subwoofer and Center Channel for 10 seconds and try again.

How to Re-Pair Bluetooth Remote Control

- 1. Ensure Center Channel is powered on.
- 2. On the Remote Control, hold down **Volume** + and simultaneously for 10 seconds.
 - The red LED on the Remote Control will blink for two seconds, then turn off.
- **3.** Change volume with the Remote Control to verify successful pairing.
