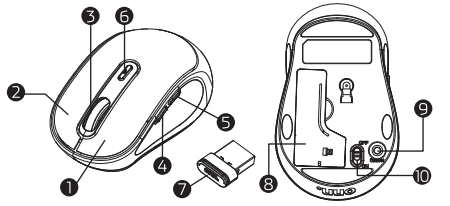

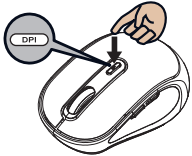

Installing the batteries

Step 2: Insert the battery as shown inside the battery compartment.

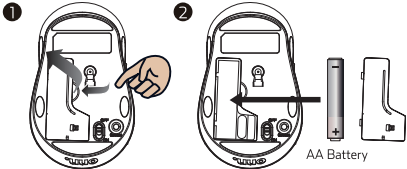
Step 3: Replace the cover.

*Please insert the battery with the correct position according to the instruction labeled on the mouse.

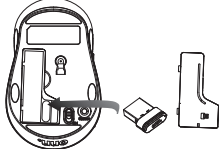

Setup the Connection between the Receiver and the Mouse

1. Insert the battery into the mouse, then follow the steps below.
2. In the meantime, to open the mouse under the cover, take the nano receiver out.
3. Plug the Nano receiver into the USB port on your computer.



4. If the mouse does not work, please put it into pairing mode.
5. Pairing: Re-plug the receiver into the USB port on your computer, then press the connect button on the mouse. If the mouse does not work after 10 seconds, pair them again. Keep the mouse closer to the receiver while in pairing mode.

LED Indicator



- Red LED is on for 10 Sec. Power On
- Red LED Blinking for 10 Sec. Low Battery Warning
- Red LED Blinking Pairing (LED OFF when paired or failed after 10 sec.)
