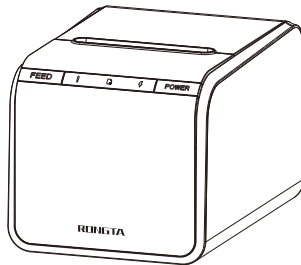
■ Front View

■ Connect Power Cord

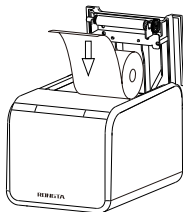
- 1.Open back cover of printer;
- 2.Connect adapter to printer;
- 3.Connect power cord to adapter;
- 4.Connect another end of power cord to socket nearby.

■ Connect Cable

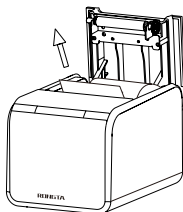
- 1.Connect cable to printer ;

2. pull the paper roll out over the roller;



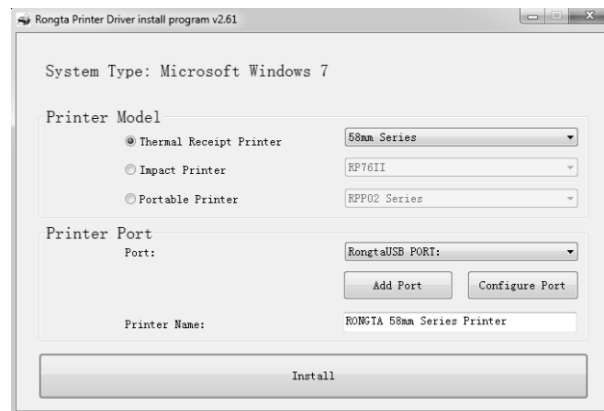
3. Close front cover of printer,press forward until hearing "ka" of front cover,which means closed.
