Objective




AC 120V/60 Hz, Line





Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

All final data was recorded in Quasi-peak detection mode for frequency range of 30 MHz -1 GHz and peak and Average detection modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.

Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

BDR (GFSK): Number of Hopping Channels




Pulse time, Middle Channel, DH3




Pulse time, Low Channel, DH5


Pulse time, Low Channel, 2DH3






Pulse time, Middle Channel, 2DH5


Pulse time, High Channel, 3DH1




Pulse time, Middle Channel, 3DH3




Pulse time, Low Channel, 3DH5

Pulse time, Middle Channel, 3DH5


