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

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4.1.3 **Test procedures**

The basic test procedure was in accordance with ANSI C63.10 (section 12).

- The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 1.5 meters (above 1GHz) and 0.8 meters (below 1GHz) above the ground at a 3 meters semi-anechoic chamber. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower.
- c. The antenna is a broadband antenna, and its height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then the antenna was tuned to heights from 1 meter to 4 meters and the rotatable table was turned from 0 degrees to 360 degrees to find the maximum reading.
- e. The test-receiver system was set to Peak Detect Function and Specified Bandwidth with Maximum Hold Mode.
- f. For below 30MHz, a loop antenna with its vertical plane is place 3m from the EUT and rotated about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth about the EUT. And the centre of the loop shall be 1m above the ground.
- g. Duringthe test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, For battery operated equipment, the equipment tests shall be perform using fresh batteries. The turntable was rotated to maximize the emission level.


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

Below 30MHztest setup




Below 1GHz test setup

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4.4 20dB Bandwidth measurement

4.4.1 Limit of 20dB bandwidth measurement

According to FCC 15.231(c), The bandwidth of the emission shall be no wider than 0.25% of the center frequency for devices operating above 70 MHz and below 900 MHz. Bandwidth is determined at the points 20 dB down from the modulated carrier.

The spectrum analyzer was receiving the maximum emission level. The 20dB bandwidth is defined as the total spectrum the power of which is higher than peak power minus 20dB.






4.5.3 Test Procedure

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
