### Home screen

Press and hold widgets to place them on the home screen as shown below.

### Widgets

To add a widget, press and hold anywhere on the home screen, and select the "Widgets" option.

### Notifications panel

Swipe up indicator on the home screen to access the Apps Screen.

### Notifications panel

Swipe down from the top edge of the screen to display the Notifications panel where you can browse and reply to your emails, check software updates, reminders and more.

### Quick Settings panel

Swipe down twice from the top edge of the screen to display the Quick Settings panel where you can turn on and off Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Airplane mode and other settings.

### Quick Settings panel

To access more settings options, select the icon.

### Connecting

To enable/disable Wi-Fi or Bluetooth®, simply tap the icons on the Quick Settings panel as shown below.

### Expanding the storage

**Inserting a Micro SD card**

To install a Micro SD card into the tablet, carefully insert the card as shown below into the card slot until it clicks and locks into place.

To remove the Micro SD card, gently press it inward to eject.

Micro SD card is not included.

### Transferring files

- Connect the tablet to the computer using the included Micro USB cable as shown below.
- Tap the notification on the tablet screen.
- Select "Transfer files".

### Miscellaneous

**Reset**

If the tablet malfunctions or freezes, you can use the Reset button to restart it.

To reset the tablet, take a metal pin (such as the end of a paper clip) and gently push the recessed Reset button on the back of the tablet as shown below.

The tablet will restart.

**Text-To-Speech**

Google Text-to-speech powers applications to read the text on your screen aloud. For example, it can be used by:

- Google Play Books to Read Aloud your favorite book
- Google Translate to speech translations aloud so that you can hear the pronunciation of a word
- TalkBack and accessibility applications for spoken feedback across your device
- ... and many other applications in the Play Store

To use Google Text-to-speech on your Android device, go to **Settings>Languages & Input-Text-to-speech output**. Select **Google Text-to-speech Engine** as your preferred engine.
