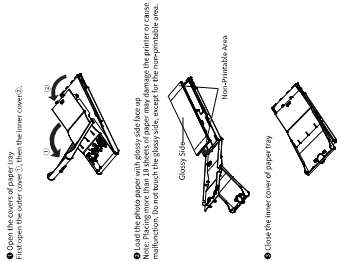

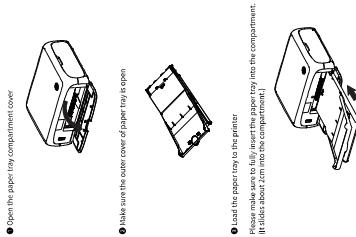
Loading the Ribbon



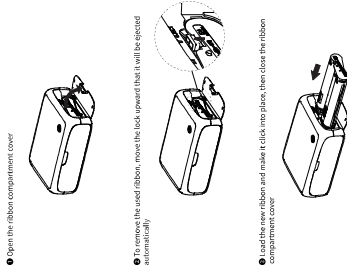
Loading the Photo Paper

Instructions for Button Operation

When the printer is powered on, hold down the power button for 3 seconds, the yellow LED indicator is lighting.

- Turn off the printer: hold down the power button for 3 seconds and then release it, the LED indicator will be off.
- Reset of mode in power-on status, hold down the power button until the blue LED indicator is lighting, then release the power button, the printer will enter the factory configuration; after resetting, the LED indicator will turn white.

Instruction for LED Indicator

LED indicator	Status
Yellow, lighting	The system is starting
White, lighting	The printer is ready (Not in sleep mode)
Green, lighting	The printer is in sleep mode (in sleep mode)
White, slow flash	Ribbon has no exit
Red, lighting	Ribbon is abnormal
Red, slow flash	Page sensor ribbon is jammed
Red, slow flash	Print over temperature
Yellow, slow flash	Firmware is updating

Working Position

- Please place the printer on the desk or other flat and stable surfaces.
- Leave some space (at least 10cm) behind the printer for paper out when printing.

Printing Wirelessly from Smartphones (AP Mode)

- Please make sure that the LED indicator of the printer is lighting when at the time.
- Open the Bluetooth app, click "Bluetooth", select the images to print and then click "Next".
- The images in print preview will display the address (see on the left print corner; shown "Zewa 1966XXXX" and click to connect, XXXX is last four digits of Bluetooth MAC address. Showed on the bottom of the printer)
- After connecting, the printer will start to print the photos.

Printing Wirelessly from Smartphones (STA Mode)

- Make sure that the printer has been connected to the Wi-Fi hotspot.
- Open the Bluetooth app, click "Bluetooth", select the images to print and then click "Next".
- Adjust the images in print preview and click the printer icon on the top right corner;
- "Zewa 1966XXXX" and click to connect, XXXX is last four digits of Bluetooth MAC address showed on the bottom of the printer)
- Enter the password of Wi-Fi hotspot, click "Configure Wi-Fi" and the green LED indicator will start to flash, after the connection is successful, the printer will start to print the photos.
- After connecting, the green LED indicator is lighting, and the printer will start to print the photos.

Note: The above instructions take photo album printing for example, for GMS, AR and Credentials printing, please experience on your own according to the guide of App.

Printing via USB from a Computer

- Connect the USB cable to your computer and the other end to the Micro USB port on the back of the printer.
- Turn on the printer.
- Download the printer driver from IDPRT website or the QR code below and install it, as you could be helped.
- After connecting, you can print the photos from the computer.

Precautions

- The best operating temperature is 15°C-45°C. If the environmental temperature is too high, the print quality may be affected.
- Please do not use the unoriginal adaptor color ink and photo paper to ensure the print quality.
- Please do not touch the film of color ink and the glossy side of photo paper in case of fingerprints that may affect the print quality.
- During printing, the area around the thermal print head is very hot. Do not touch it, as you could be burned.
- Please do not touch the photo paper by force during printing, or else it may damage the printer.
- Please remove the paper tray when it is not used for a long time, and clean the covers of the printer and the paper tray to avoid dust entering.
