IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

We thank you for choosing our product. To ensure your safety and health, please use this equipment correctly. It is important to read this entire manual before assembling and using the equipment. Safe and effective use can only be achieved if the equipment is assembled, maintained, and used properly. It is your responsibility to ensure that all users of the equipment are informed of all warnings and precautions.

- 1. Before starting any exercise program, you should consult your physician to determine if you have any medical or physical conditions that could put your health and safety at risk or prevent you from using the equipment properly. Your physician's advice is essential if you are taking medication that affects your heart rate, blood pressure, or cholesterol level.
- 2. Be aware of your body's signals. Incorrect or excessive exercise can damage your health. Stop exercising if you experience any of the following symptoms: pain, tightness in your chest, irregular heartbeat, shortness of breath, lightheadedness, dizziness, or feelings of nausea. If you do experience any of these conditions, you should consult your physician before continuing with your exercise program.
- 3. Keep children and pets away from the equipment. The equipment is designed for adult use only.
- 4. Use the equipment on a solid, flat level surface with a protective cover for your floor or carpet. To ensure safety, the equipment should have at least 8 feet (240 CM) of free space behind it and 2 feet (60 CM) on each side. Do not place the SUNNY TreadPad on any surface that blocks air openings. To protect the floor or carpet from damage, place a mat under the SUNNY TreadPad.
- 5. Ensure that all nuts and bolts are securely tightened before using the equipment. The safety of the equipment can only be maintained if it is regularly examined for damage and/or wear and tear.
- 6. Always use the equipment as indicated. If you find any defective components while assembling or checking the equipment, or if you hear any unusual noises coming from the equipment during exercise, discontinue use of the equipment immediately and do not use until the problem has been rectified.
- 7. Wear suitable clothing while using the equipment. Avoid wearing loose clothing that may become entangled in the equipment.
- 8. Do not place fingers or objects into the moving parts of the equipment.
- 9. The maximum weight capacity of this unit is 220 pounds (100 KG).
- 10. The equipment is not suitable for therapeutic use.
- 11. To avoid bodily injury and/or damage to the product or property, proper lifting and moving are required.
- 12. Your product is intended for use in cool and dry conditions. You should avoid storage in extreme cold, hot or damp areas as this may lead to corrosion and other related problems.
- 13. This equipment is designed for indoor and home use only; it is not intended for commercial use.
- 14. When running, try to use shoes with rubber soles, otherwise there will be the possibility of static electricity.




▲ IMPORTANT NOTE:

The belt must be lubricated before the first use! Please see Page 12 for instructions on how to properly apply lubricant.

IMPORTANT OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please keep a rear distance of 240cm (94.5 inches) or more.
- 2. Please keep a distance of 50cm (20 inches) or more on both left and right side.
- 3. Please choose sport shoes when using the Sunny TreadPad.
- 4. Please do not stand up on the Sunny TreadPad if the machine is recalibrating.
- 5. It is not recommended to use the Sunny TreadPad on uneven surfaces.
- 6. Use caution when folding the Sunny TreadPad to avoid injury.
- 7. Do not fold the machine if the Sunny TreadPad is turned on.
- 8. Please pull out the power cord from the outlet when the Sunny TreadPad is not in use.
- 9. Always face forward to prevent dizziness from occurring.
- 10. Never allow multiple users to operate the machine at the same time.
- 11. Please keep pets away from the Sunny TreadPad.
- 12. Do not stand on the front end of the Sunny TreadPad.
- 13. Minors must be accompanied by an adult.
- 14. Running or walking sideways or backwards on the Sunny TreadPad is prohibited.
- 15. Please do not use the Sunny TreadPad if you are not within the age recommendations or if you are pregnant.







EXPLODED DIAGRAM





STEP 1:


Place the Sunny TreadPad on a flat surface. It is not recommended to place the Sunny TreadPad on a soft or uneven surface.

Open the handrail upward



STEP 2:


Take out the Type knob shaft(#8) from the accessory box, insert it into the hole of handrail shaft, and rotate clockwise to lock the handrails on both sides



STEP 3:

Take the safety key out of the accessory box, insert it into the clip socket located in the middle of the handrail

Connect the power supply




STEP 5:

Scan the QR barcode to directly locate SUNNY HEALTH & FITNESS App in the App Store on your device. In order to scan the QR Code, you must first download the QR READER App on your device. Available in both Apple App Store & Google Play Store.

Use the remote to directly skip 5 steps


Open APP to complete registration and connect the device step by step.



STEP 6:

Connect music box

Open the system Bluetooth, search for Bluetooth named SUNNY, click on to connect, when it's connected you can play music by the music box.




STEP 7:

Align the hole and insert the safety clip into the safety socket, and clip the other end to your clothing.

BATTERY INSTALLATION & REPLACEMENT



BATTERY INSTALLATION:

- 1. Remove the battery cover.
- 2. Install the battery (AAA) into the battery holder by the right side .
- 3. Put the battery cover back.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT:


- 1. Remove the battery cover.
- 2. Take out the 2pcs battery (AAA) that is included inside the remote control box.
- 3. Install the battery (AAA) into the battery holder .
- 4. Put the battery cover back.

Dispose the old battery according to your regional guidelines.

MAINTENANCE & ADJUSTMENTS GUIDE


Cleaning the Sunny TreadPad:

- Unplug the unit from the electrical source before you begin.
- Pour a small amount of gentle detergent on a cotton rag or towel. Do not pour the detergent on the running belt directly and do not use acidic or corrosive cleaners.
- Wipe down the frame, motor encasement, and running belt. Do not wipe underneath the running belt.
- After a long period of use, it is normal for dust to accumulate. Please wipe the dust of gently.




Adjusting the Belt:

- Start the SUNNY TreadPad and set the speed 2.5 mi/h.
- If the running belt moves to the left: Turn the left adjusting screw half-circle clockwise.
- If the running belt moves to the right: Turn the right adjusting screw half-circle clockwise.
- If the running belt is slipping: Turn both left and right adjusting screws half-circle clockwise at same time.



Lubricating the running belt:

- Unplug the unit from the electrical source before you begin.
- Lift up the running belt and apply the silicone lubricant underneath the surface of the running belt.
- Power on the Sunny TreadPad.
- Allow the SUNNY TreadPad to operate at 2.5 mi/h for 10 to 20 seconds.
- Do not add more than 5 ml 10 ml of lubricant. The running belt will slip if it has too much lubricant.
- Apply Silicone lubricant once every 3 months.

KEY FUNCTIONS

MODE INSTRUCTION:

(J)

Standby Mode

Light of the Standby mode is on. Motor and sensor stop response.

M

Constant Speed Mode

Light of the fixed speed mode is on.

Control the speed through the remote control or APP.

A

Automatic Mode


Light of the automatic mode is on.

Speed is automatically controlled.

STANDBY MODE:



In this mode, the SUNNY TreadPad stops responding to prevent non-users from triggering the SUNNY TreadPad.



SUNNY TreadPad will automatically stand by and lock when it is not in use for more than 10 minutes. When the SUNNY TreadPad is stopped, it can also be locked manually by pressing the Mode button for more than 2 seconds. Hold press Start or Mode for 2 seconds to unlock again.


FIXED SPEED MODE (PRIMARY MODE):



In this mode, the speed of the SUNNY TreadPad can be controlled by the remote. Beginners are advised to use the constant speed mode first, and then use the auto mode after being proficient in using the SUNNY TreadPad. In this mode, if the user leaves the SUNNY TreadPad for more than 30 seconds, it will stop automatically!

When the handrail is upward, the maximum speed is 7.5mi/h which is suitable for running. The safety key must be plugged in to start.

When the handrail is putted down, the maximum speed is 3.75mi/h which is suitable for walking. You can start the TreadPad with the safety key or not.




AUTOMATIC MODE:




This mode is an advanced mode with higher level, and can be completely separated from remote control after starting. It is recommended for users with better coordination or experienced in use of SUNNY TreadPad.

When the handrail is upward, the maximum speed is 5mi/h which is suitable for running. The safety key must be plugged in to start.

When the handrail is putted down, the maximum speed is 3.75mi/h which is suitable for walking. You can start the TreadPad with the safety key or not.





In the auto mode, when running on the belt, the SUNNY TreadPad will accelerate step by step until the speed is consistent with the pace frequency. When the stride length slows down, the SUNNY TreadPad speed will gradually slow down until the speed is consistent with the stride frequency. When the speed is decreased less than 1.5mi/h, the SUNNY TreadPad will stop automatically.

Note: Automatic acceleration and deceleration will have the process of learning and adaptation. Some people will not adapt to it at first, and it will be easier after frequent usage.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

REMOTE CONTROL NOTICE

If the remote control has no response or you replace to a new one, the remote control and SUNNY TreadPad device need to be paired.

REMOTE CONTROL PAIRING METHOD:

Restart the Sunny TreadPad. Press and hold down the mode switch button on the remote control immediately for about 2 seconds. Hearing a "Beep" indicates that the pairing is success. During the pairing, the remote control should be as close to the Sunny TreadPad as possible.

SAFETY LOCK FUNCTION:

Removing the Safety Key (No.67) will stop the SUNNY TreadPad immediately. Once the SUNNY TreadPad reaches a full stop, the remote display will show "SAFE" and the SUNNY TreadPad will beep. To start the SUNNY TreadPad again, insert the Safety Key (No.67) and press the start button on the remote or APP.

ERROR CODES:

When the SUNNY TreadPad is running normally, the fault code does not display. When a fault occurs, the remote controller displays the error code.


