The power adapters are intended to be correctly connected to a verified power source position. The prongs are not designed to hold the plug in place if it is plugged into a ceiling, under-the-table or cabinet outlet.

For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.

- Make sure your baby unit and parent unit are more than 1 meter (3 feet) apart, OR
- Turn down the volume of your parent unit.

NOTE

- To avoid interference from other electronic devices place your baby monitor at least 3 feet (1 meter) away from devices such as wireless routers, microwaves, cell phones and computers.

Once you power on both your baby unit and parent unit, your parent unit displays image from the baby unit, and the **LINK** LED light turns on.

Tip

- Press any keys on the parent unit to turn on the screen again.

Battery status

- animates when the battery is charging
