SwitchBot Hub S1

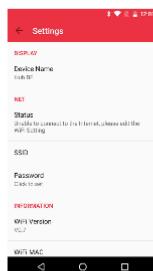
1. Power on your SwitchBot Hub and launch the SwitchBot App downloaded from your app store.



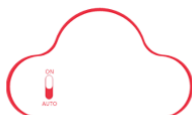
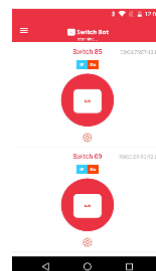
2. Start to add your Hub from the left side menu. Then set the backside switch of the device from "AUTO" to "ON" .



3. Follow the app instructions to add the device and set your local SSID and password of your WiFi router. The Hub will start rainbow showing after successfully connected to a WiFi router.

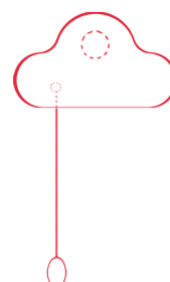


4. Back to the main page in the App and now you are ready to control SwitchBots via this Hub.



ON (top): Light is always on; Pairing mode within 10 minutes.
OFF (middle): Light is always off.
Auto (bottom): Light will be activated when the Hub status changes.

(Optional) Peel off the tape and stick the magnet to a wall. Then attach your Hub to the magnet and enjoy.
