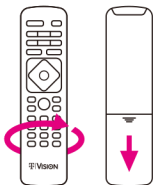
### Function Introduction

Please install two AAA batteries

Pairing: Boot into the main interface, while holding down the  $\odot$  key and  $\ominus$  key for 3 seconds, After the indicator light flashes, release the button. Wait for the pairing is successful, you can use.

Please complete the pairing operation within 60s after entering the main interface.

Pairing is successful, the next boot without pairing again, can be used directly.



### Remote trouble?

If you're having remote trouble, press the Remote button on the Streaming device for 3 seconds to pair it again.

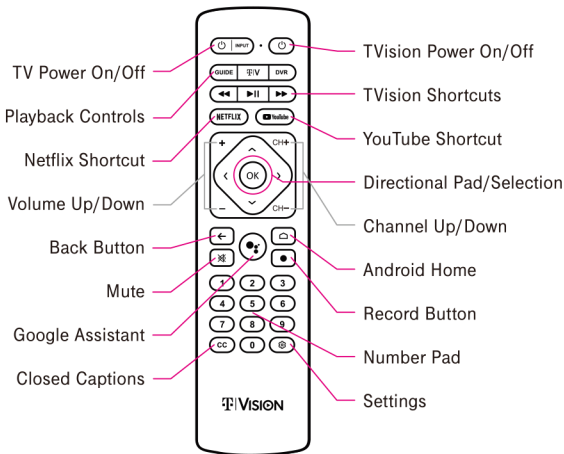
## Connect your remote
