According to 47 CFR 2.925(d)

In order to validate the grant of equipment authorization, the nameplate or label shall be permanently affixed to the equipment and shall be readily visible to the purchaser at the time of purchase.

Here is a Wi-Fi 6 AP, the FCC ID label need to be pulled out to see. Please refer to the attachment for the label location photos of the product.

I The consumers will see the "Product information" from the outside of the equipment enclosure.

I Pull out the "drawer" and you will see the FCC ID label.

I The "drawer" cannot be completely removed from the device, its end will be stuck, which ensures that the label will not be separated from the device.

I The FCC ID label is permanently affixed to the "drawer".

Does this design meet the FCC's requirements for the FCC ID label?
