




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### Test plot of Maximum Peak Conducted Output Power:



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



CH 0 (2402.0 MHz)







### 6dB Bandwidth of Fundamental Emission on GFSK (2402MHz)







#### 6dB Bandwidth of Fundamental Emission on GFSK (2440MHz)







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



### Band-edge Compliance of RF Emissions – Highest (GFSK)














Measurement of Radiated Emission Test Set Up (30MHz to 1000MHz)







