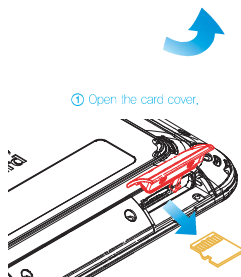

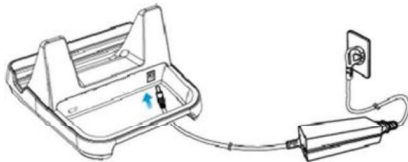

2.LCD Protect Film

► Caution

Before application	Choose a dust-free place to apply the film. Wash your hands and clean your LCD perfectly. Adhesive side protection vinyl is only to be removed right before applying the film on your LCD.
During application	Be careful not to stain the adhesive side with dirt like dust or fingerprint. In case the adhesive side is stained, cleaning it with water will make the film unusable.
After application	White spots or white scratches may be seen after application. Unless they appear because of dirt, the spots or lines disappear within 24 hours as adhesive substances stabilize.

Due to the product's nature, it is not exchangeable or refundable even when the application was not successful.

► How to apply the protective film



Step1 Check film size and Clean your LCD

Place the film on your LCD to check its size and think how to apply it on your LCD.
Align the protective film to the screen edges to make sure the film is adhered at the center of your LCD.
Clean the surface using the cleaner included to avoid dust or hairs.
No single dirt should be left.



Step2 Remove one third of the adhesive side protection vinyl and Start application

Remove about one third of the adhesive side protection vinyl, and accurately adhere the protective film from left to right on the upper part of your LCD.
Remove the protection vinyl little by little while applying the film on your LCD.
The parts of film from which the adhesive side protection vinyl is removed will naturally be attached to the LCD.
When air bubbles appear, lift the film a little up and release it, or use soft cloth to press any bubble trapped inside out towards the edges.



Tip In case any dust or dirt is trapped between the film and the screen

Attach a piece of transparent tape on a corner of the LCD and lift up the tape (undesired the film is sawn).
Remove the dust from the adhesive side with another piece of transparent tape.
Be careful not to stain the adhesive side of the film with any dust, dirt or transparent tape's adhesives.

Q & A

Q Water went into my device. What do I do?

- A** After drying for a good period of time, try to turn it on. If it still does not turn on, the main-board or other parts needs to be replaced.
Please contact to your service center.

Q The ET100 won't turn on.

- A** The program may be damaged. Please try resetting your device.
If it still doesn't work, Please contact the service center.

Q The ET100 won't charge.

- A** A Make sure the power cable and your device have been properly connected.
Try to clean the charging terminals. If they still do not work, your battery life might be finished or it may be a broken battery.
(The battery warranty lasts for 6 months)

Q How do I get the repair service?

- A** You can send the device via a delivery service to headquarter.
When sending the package, make sure you pay for the shipping fee in advance.
