- 1. Please provide a photo of the underside of the board shown in photo number 2 xxx
- 2. Please note that the adapter for AC shown on page 87 of the manual is a European style AC adapter. For use in the US, the manual should reflect proper US adapter information. xxx
- 3. Please note that the 731 form provided is not clear. Please provide a readable version of the 731. xxx
- 4. Please provide the calibration due dates for the test equipment used. xxx
- 5. IEEE1528 says that the power should be verified during the SAR testing phase. Output power is to be verified for each configuration. If this cannot be done then adequate explanation of how the power requirements were met needs to be in the report. Please note that the power measured on the device at the EMC lab is not verification of the actual power level to which the unit may have been at during SAR testing. Please provide evidence that the power requirements of par 5.3.3 of 1528 have been met. xxx
- Please note that an outline of the EUT should be on the plots so as to indicate where on the device maximum SAR exists. Please provide plots showing an outline of the device in relation to SAR levels. xxx
