

Placing Your Camera on a Flat Surface

- ▶ Hang the ball mount on the camera stand.
- ▶ Place the camera on the ball mount.
- ▶ Adjust camera position as desired.

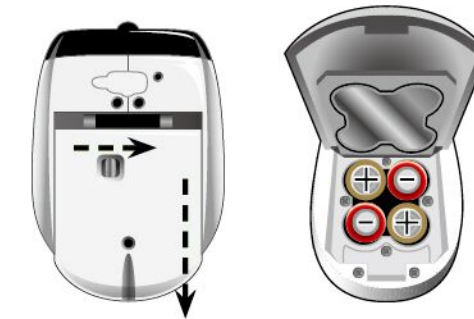

CAMERA SETUP

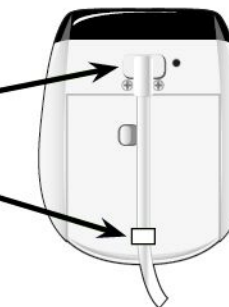
Inserting the Batteries

- ▶ Open battery compartment.
- ▶ Insert four (4) AA *Energizer* Ultimate Lithium™ (L91) batteries in the orientation shown.



Using the Powercord Adapter

- ▶ Plug your power adapter into a wall outlet.
- ▶ Plug USB end of the power adapter into the camera.
- ▶ Plug power adapter strain relief into the hole in the battery cover.

- ▶ Install the mounting screw into the wall.
- ▶ Hang the ball mount on the mounting screw.
- ▶ Place the camera on the ball mount.
- ▶ Adjust camera position as desired.
