Cleaning and Maintaining

Before Using

SIM

Before using your phone you must insert a valid SIM (Subscriber Identity Module) card. SIM card provide by the network provider.

Warning: Be sure to remove the SIM phone off before. There is absolutely prohibited in the case of an external power supply connected to insert or remove the SIM, or SIM card and mobile phone may be damaged.

Phone Unlock

In order to prevent illegal use, your phone can set the phone lock password protected. Use this function, you must enter the phone lock password so that you can unlock the phone into the normal use state.

Enter the phone lock password, press the LSK to confirm. For example, if the phone lock password is set to 1234, then the following input: 1234.

SIM Unlock

In order to prevent illegal use of your SIM with PIN (Personal Identification Number) password encryption protection. Use this function, if you have set the PIN password protection, every time you must enter the PIN password at boot time, so that you can unlock the SIM card and phone to normal use. Enter the PIN password, press the LSK to confirm. For example, if the PIN is set to 1234, then the following input: 1234.If there consecutive incorrect, your SIM will be network locked, the phone will ask for PUK password.

Function menu Introduction

Contacts

You can use the contacts to store records, can store the following: name and phone number. In the contacts list, select a record, to make a call when you press the dial keys. Select a record in the contacts, you can do the following:

- **-View** View the contact details or edit record.
- **-Send text message** Send text message to this number.
- **-Call** Make a call to the number.
- **-Edit** Can edit and save record.
- **-Delete** Delete the record.
- **-Copy** Copy the current record to Phone/SIM.
 - **-Delete multiple** You can delete multiple records.

-Import/Export contacts You can Import/Expor contacts from phone to phone.

- -Contacts settings:
- **-Speed dial** Open speed dial. If you long press number keys on the dialing interface, you can call up.
 - **-Own number** View local SIM card number.
 - **-Service number** You can call the service number.
- **-Memory status** View the usage and total **Contacts** capacity information.

Dialed calls

Enter the dialed calls menu to display the current record of outgoing phone list of phone numbers. Please refer to missed calls for details.

Received calls

Enter the received calls menu to display the current record has been received mobile phone number list. Please refer to missed calls for details.

Rejected calls

Enter the rejected calls menu to display the current record has been rejected mobile phone number list. Please refer to missed calls for details.

Delete call logs

Press the LSK to select "OK" to delete call records.

Call timers

See SIM 1 and SIM 2 call timers.

Messaging

Make sure that the information in writing before the message center number is set correctly. Access to an information menu, you can edit the SMS message.

Write message

Edit SMS message contents.

Inbox

Messages which are received.

Outbox

Storage location when sending SMS.

Drafts

Draft messages.

Sentbox

Sent messages.

SMS templates

SMS template content.

Security inbox

After moving important messages to the security inbox, a password is required to view them.

SMS settings

SIM1\SIM2: This menu can set SMS validity period delivery report.

reply path. Save sent messages. Export SMS and Auto signature.

Memory status: View the SIM and Phone capacity information.

Text msg. counter: Received message counter of SIM1/SIM2.

Preferred storage: Can set preferred storage as SIM or phone.

Voice mail server: can set a voice service number.

Bluetooth

Power: Turn on bluetooth or not. **Visibility:** You can set it on/off.

My device: You can search for nearby bluetooth devices and pair

them.

Camera

Video recorder

Recorder

Advanced settings

Auto redial:

Through on / off settings, to activate or disable the feature. Turned on and when your phone call after another failed attempt to connect up to redial 10 times. This feature can save you the trouble of repeated calls.

Call time reminder:

Off: Close the function.

Periodic: Enter any number between 1-60 (sec), from the input time (in seconds), remind for periodic.

Reject by SMS:
