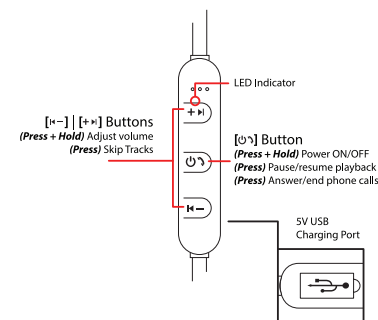

## Getting Started

### Charging the Earbuds

Attach the small connector of the supplied micro-USB cable to the USB charging port on the side of the earbuds. Attach the large connector to the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

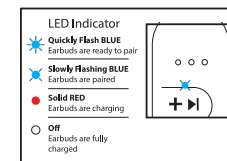
The LED indicator will **turn RED** while charging and turn off when fully charged. When low on power, a tone will be heard, indicating that the earbuds should be charged.

### Power ON/OFF

- Press and hold the [P] button to power the earbuds ON/OFF.
- When powered ON, the earbuds will automatically reconnect to the device they were most recently paired to, so long as that device is within connection range (30 ft.) and Bluetooth is enabled.

### Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the earbuds ON. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator will **quickly flash BLUE**.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **TCU018** from the list of found devices.
3. Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will **slowly flash BLUE**.



### Playing Music

To listen to music on your earbuds, make sure they are paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device. For more on pairing the earbuds to your device, please consult the **Bluetooth Pairing** section of this user manual.

Once paired, you can control media playback and volume adjustment with the earbuds' controls or the ones on your paired device.

### Controlling Playback & Volume

- Press the [P] button to pause/resume media playback.
- Press the [M-] and [M+] buttons to skip tracks.
- Press and hold the [M-] and [M+] buttons to adjust volume. A tone will be heard if trying to increase the volume past the maximum level.

### Phone Calls

- Press the [P] button to answer an incoming phone call. Press again to end the phone call.
- Press and hold the [P] button to ignore an incoming phone call.
- Double press the [P] button to redial the last phone number called.
