Large-capacity rear-extraction dust box, washable HEPA filter, split mopping module, and two-in-one electronically controlled water tank support the efficient cleaning mode of sweeping first and mopping later.

You can also download the APP on your mobile phone to view the cleaning map and running status of the robot vacuum cleaner in real time, cleaning time, switching cleaning mode, spot cleaning, voice control, remote control, etc.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following: READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING (THIS APPLIANCE), Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

WARNING- To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- ·Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children, pets or plants.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- ·Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- $\cdot \text{Do not handle the charging dock, including charger plug, and charger terminals with wet hands.} \\$
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.

- ·Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- · Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes,
- ·Do not use without dust box and filter in place.
- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting to battery pack, picking up or carrying the appliance. Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing the appliance that has the switch on invites accidents.
- ·Do not use and store in extremely hot or cold environments (below 0°C/ 32°F or above 40°C/104°F). Please charge the robot in temperature above 0°C/ 32°F and below 40°C/104°F.
- Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
- · Use appliances only with specifically designated battery packs. Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- ·When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects, that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.

- ·GR2 charging dock. Use only with Dongguan Sunun Power Co., Ltd SA182H-200090U charger or Chanzeho Technology (HK) Co Ltd CZH024200090USWM charger.

- · Unplug before cleaning or servicing.

Press and hold the Dock Button on the robot for 20 seconds until the Wi-Fi module is turned off.


When the Wi-Fi module is turned off, press any button on the robot to turn the Wi-Fi module on.




Installation steps

1.Connect the power cord, and then
Put the excess wire into the wire box



2. Place the charging stand against a wall on a flat floor, and then connect power




Note:

- Make sure there is a space of more than 0.5 meters on both sides and more than 1.5 meters in $\,$ f r o n $\,$
- ·When installing, try to keep the power cord in the air; if it is close to the ground, it may be dragged by the host, causing the charging stand to lose power.
- •The charging indicator light is always on when the power is on

3. install brush

Put (R brush) and letters R in bottom case into bottom respectively



Turn on the main power switch,until the indicator light is always on,and then put the host on the charging stand to charge



Note:


With Insu f ficient power cannot being turned on please place the host on the charging stan d,the device will automatically turn on,because the device can w o rknormally only when the power is $\ge\!20\%$

(as the picture shows) The front end of the machine is facing the char ging stand, so that the charging contacts on the main unit are in contact with the charging shrap nel, and the distance batween the front end of the machine and the charging stand is about $0{\sim}2\text{CM}$

mopping components

1.install two-in-one water pump tank

①Install the rag:Glue the mop flat to the bottom of the mop holder



② method of collecting water: Open the lid and fill it with water and close the lid





Note:

It is recommended to remove thedust box and then add water to avoid water entering the dust box.


Lift the handle first, take the dust box out of the water tank, then fill it with water and fasten the lid 3 install water box



Put the dust box into the water tank and lay the handle flat



Press and hold the button in the middle of the water tank and push it When you hear a "click",it is in place



Press and hold the two buttons in the middle of the mop bracket along the back of the main unit

Push it in horizontally until you hear a "click" sound to indicate it is in place

2.Remove the electronically controlled water tank
When the main unit finishes work, press and hold the two
buttons in the middle of the mop holder, remove the mop
holder backwards, and place the cleaning cloth(Do not
move or flip the main unit during work)



After removing the mop bracket, press and hold the button in the middle of the water tank and pull it out horizontally along the back of the main unit, pour out the remaining water in the water tank, and remove the garbage in the dust box. (Do not move or flip the host during work)



3.Instructions for use

- ① Do not use the water tank when no one person is at home
- ② For safety, be sure to remove the water tank when charging or not in use
- ③ Do not use the mopping function on the carpet. You can prevent the device from entering the carpet by setting a forbidden area.
- 4 In order to obtain a better mopping effect, it is recommended to install the mopping module after cleaning it three times for the first using
- ⑤ If you need to add water or clean the rag during the operation, please pause in place first, follow the above steps, and then restart
- ⑥ The mopping function of the equipment only has the ef ect of wiping, which is helpful for deep cleaning, but cannot ef ectively remove stubborn stains and cannot completely replace manual labor

Instructions for use

Power(ON/OFF):

(1)turn"ON",After flashing Blue breathing light POWER ON in English",and then it works (2)turn"OFF",Cut offthe power supply, which mean it's shutdown completely.

Power key(note:tutning"ON"means it works):

(1)powering off: press \circlearrowleft With 3 seconds, After flashing white lig andhear "POWER ON" Shutdown to complete

(2)In the power-on state, long press \circlearrowleft the switch and the power-off complete button for 3S, the breathing light goes out, and the voice announces "shutdown completed"

Sweeping/Pause

After working, press $\mbox{\Large O}$ Or use the mobile APP to start the automatic cleaning or pause function

Note:

- ·Sweeping robot cannot be used to clean liquid
- If the power is lower than 20%, the cleaning task cannot be performed,
- ·Please charge first and then continue cleaning

being lower than 20% during the cleaning process, the device will automatically recharge $\,$

·Please remove all kinds of wires on the ground before cleaning

Start the recharge or control the recharge by the mobile phone APP, the Blue breathing light will be always on when the machine is charging. Note: If the charging base is not found, the host will automatically return to the starting position.

Please manually put the host back on the charging stand for charging

The mobile phone APP controls the recharging. When the machine is charging, the white breathing light is always on. Note: If the charging stand is not found, the host will automatically return to the starting position. Please manually put the host back on the charging stand for charging.

Suction adjustment

Use the remote control or mobile APP to choose three suction modes: quiet, normal, strong(Default is normal)

Water regulation (in tank mode)

Using the mobile phone APP or remote control, you can choose three water volume modes: low, medium or high(Default is mid-range)

Silent mode

Turn on the silent mode. If the device will not play the voice, you can use the mobile APP or remote control to turn on or off the silent mode

Reset WiFi

When the router's configuration, password or other reasons cause the mobile phone to fail to connect to the machine, please also: Pres () and () with 3seconds, until hearing "WiFi resetting "sounds and WiFi light will be turned It turns Blue breathing light quickly, indicating that the reset is successful. Schedule a cleaning

Use the mobile APP to set the scheduled cleaning time, the host will automatically start cleaning at the specified time,


Note:

During work, do not move the device at will and frequently

Instructions for use

Cleaning mode

After the robot is powered on, it will scan and generate the map and divide it into areas intelligently. Then sweep the areas one by one along the wall orderly, efficiently and thoroughly and plan the cleaning route in a bow/S shape. The robot will return to the charging base automatically after cleaning



Note:


Do not move the robot casually and frequently when it is cleaning. After moving, please put the robot near the original position. When it starts again, it will try to reposition itself. After successful positioning, it would follow the planned path and continue to work. If the positioning fails, the robot would abort previous mission, make a map and do the cleaning again. Even it maynot find the charging base

Spot cleaning

When a local area needs a deep sweep, the user specifies a point on the map on the APP, the machine will automatically drive to the vicinity of the point, take the point as the center, and clean within $1.5 \,\mathrm{m}\,\mathrm{x}\,1.5 \,\mathrm{m}$

Partial cleaning

When the robot cannot be controlled by the mobile APP, please remove the robot to the place you want to clean. Long press the ∆button for 3 seconds, and the robot will clean twice within the scope of 1.8mx1.8m centering on itself



Connect to the sweeping robot APP

APP download

Method 1: Go to the app store, search for "Tuya Smart" to download Method2: Scan the QR code below to download



Adding equipment

Open the APP and click the "+" button on the home page to enter the device selection page. Select the cleaning robot and complete the device addition according to the instructions

Firmware upgrade

After entering the firmware upgrade function through the mobile phone APP and detecting the new firmware, follow the prompts to guide the upgrade. Firmware upgrade requires power \geq 50%. It is recommended to place the device on the charging stand to upgrade

Reset the Wifi

When the router's configuration, password or other reasons cause the phone to fail to connect to the machine, please do the same:

Press (And (With3seconds,until hearing "WiFi resetting" and WiFi indicator (It turns Blue breathing light quickly, indicating that the reset is successful.
