2. Make sure your mobile's WiFi is turned on and connected to 2.4G band and turned on the location.
3. Power on your Air Quality Monitor. Then, press and hold the WiFi button for 3-5 seconds until you see the LED is flashing green light.
4. Select "ADD ITEM (NO HUB)" of the LEXI App; and follow the instruction to complete pairing the monitor. In pairing process, you will see the fast flashing Green light. Once it is connected, it will turn Green without flashing.
5. Your device is added to the LEXI system successfully and ready to use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- a. Ensure user distance is within 60ft without obstacles between within your LEXI Hub or your mobile phone (when being used without a hub).

- c. Make sure the green light is not flashing. The flashing green light means the connection with WiFi is not success. Please re-connect the device with WiFi.
- d. Cleaning service is paired with LEXI Hub or with your mobile phone.
- e. You can use the device by LEXI App when necessary.
- f. If you feel the measurement of data has something abnormal, You can click "Zero calibration" to select the function of LEXI App. Then, simply put the Air Quality monitor close to the window with good ventilation for 15 minutes.
