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# 1. Unlock from outside.

### 1. Lock from outside.

Press and hold Any button on the Keypad for 2 seconds

# 2. Lock from inside.

Rotate the Thumb Turn



 In Auto Lock mode, the bolt will extend out automatically to lock the door in 10 seconds. You can customize the Auto Lock time delay between 10 and 99 seconds.



**NOTE:** Auto Lock is disabled by default, it needs to be enabled manually. The lock doesn't have a built-in door sensor, if the Auto Lock is enabled, it will lock automatically whether your door is closed or open.



#### How to use the Display Screen

Press the Display Screen Button to make the Display Screen light up, then you can see outside through the screen.

**NOTE:** Display Screen is disabled by default, it needs to be enabled manually by pressing the Display Screen Button on the Interior Assembly every time you want to use it.





#### How to pair the Doorbell



**3** Press the Doorbell Button to test whether your Doorbell is paired successfully.



#### How to unpair the Doorbell

Press and hold the Volume Button for 10 seconds until the Indicator Light flashes 4 times and then goes out. It means the Doorbell has been unpaired successfully.

#### How to adjust the volume of the Doorbell

The default volume is 3, press the Volume Button once to increase the volume to the maximum of 5, then press and hold the Volume Button to decrease the volume to the minimum of 1.





#### How to switch the song of the Doorbell

Press the Previous Song Button or Next Song Button to switch the song of the Doorbell. There're a total of 38 songs available to play.





#### <u> Important:</u>

- Master Code (4 to 10 digits): The Default Master Code is **1234**. It is required that you change it to a code of your own before programming.
- User Code (4 to 10 digits): A total of 20 User Codes (including One-time User Code) can be programmed and stored.
- When setting is unsuccessful, the Indicator Light will flash **Red**.

#### Change Master Code

Press Stwice, then enter the Default Master Code, press Sonce.







Then press **1** on the Keypad.





**3** Then enter your New Master Code, and then press **3**.



Congratulations on completing this programming when the Indicator Light flashes Green!

# Before Pairing

The lock is not required to connect to the Network, so it's unable to lock / unlock but only generate the One-time Code via KK Home App.

Before pairing your lock in KK Home App, please make sure to change the default Master Code (1234) on the lock. If you will change the Master Code in future, you may need to repair your lock in KK Home App with your new Master Code.

During pairing, please make sure to enter the correct Master Code, or it may cause one-time code failure.

The UI of KK Home App may be updated, the specific operation guidance in KK Home shall prevail.



# Step 1: Register Your Account



Search and download "KK Home" in



Scan the QR code to download "KK Home" App



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Complete the register information and tap "Get code", you will receive a Verification code in the mailbox you entered to register. Enter the code you received, tap on "Create" to complete registration.



# Step 2: Pair Your Lock

Scan the QR code or input the ESN on the back of the Battery Cover manually.

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# Step 3: Generate One-time Code

After pairing your lock, tap on "Generate one-time code".





# Step 3: Generate One-time Code

Enter the One-time Codes on the Keypad to test if they work.



#### NOTE:

1. You can generate multiple One-time Codes via KK Home App. One-time Code only can be used once and will be automatically deleted after used.

2. If the generated One-time Code can't be used to open the door, please check if you have changed the Master Code on the lock and scan the QR code on the back of the Battery Cover to add your lock in KK Home App again.



- Keep the door open and unlocked.
- 2 Remove one battery, press and hold the Reset Button for 5 seconds by using the Reset Tool.
- 3 Keep holding the Reset Button and put the battery back, until you hear a long sound of beep and the Latch bolt extends out automatically.

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#### Master Code

The Default Master Code is **1234**. Before programming, it requires to change the Default Master Code to a new one.

Master Code can be used to unlock the door under Vacation Mode.

### • Fingerprint

Fingerprint is only used to **unlock from the outside**.

To add Fingerprints, place your finger on the Fingerprint scanner for **8** times. Remember to place different angles of your finger and press a little bit harder on the scanner each time.

### One-time User Code

You can add multiple One-time Codes on the lock or generate them in KK Home App. One-time Code only can be used once and will be automatically deleted after used.



### Auto Lock

In **Auto Lock** mode, the Latch bolt will extend out automatically to lock the door in **10** seconds.

Auto Lock is disabled by default. You can customize the Auto Lock time delay between **10** and **99** seconds.

#### One-touch Lock

One-touch Lock is pressing and holding **Any button** on the Keypad for **2** seconds **to lock from outside**.

# • Wrong Entry Limit

After **10** times unsuccessful attempts at entering an invalid code, the device will shut down for **3** minutes.



# Vacation Mode

Enabling the Vacation Mode will restrict all User Codes and Fingerprints until Master Code is entered on the Keypad. If it's unlocked by the Thumb Turn from the inside, the lock will sound an alarm.

# Silent Mode

The beep sounds when pressing Keypad can be muted. But you will still hear low battery and system alerts.

# Anti-peeping Passcode

Entering random numbers before or after correct passcode will also unlock the door, which can prevent the passcode being exposed. The length of anti-peeping passcode should be within 16 digits.
