I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

- 1. Please note that while section 7 of the SAR report shows head SAR data for the cheek and tilt positions, it appears that you have only provided SAR test plots and results for GPRS mode and one DCS head mode. A number of the GPRS modes state head phantom sections. This indicates that GPRS data mode could be used while held to the ear (i.e. voice capable). Currently however, GPRS is generally for data mode use and would be expected to be used to be used in body worn configurations. Please clarify the GPRS configurations (i.e. is it expected that GPRS would be used in voice communications while held to the ear or will GPRS mode only be body worn data configurations?)
- In regards to item 1, Please provide the SAR data and plots for all appropriate head positions for GSM mode (i.e. right and left cheek; right and left tilt positions). Please also verify that SAR testing for these positions was performed at the maximum power levels.
- 3. Please note that GSM was tested only in the body worn configuration without the headset. Please explain why GSM mode was note tested in body worn configuration with the headset attached.
