


1(One) Instruction Manual Power ON/OFF

Pair Wireless speaker with your mobile device

2(Two) Wired Microphones 74.4in. (189cm) Full Length

1(One) Micro-USB Charging Cable 19.7in. (50cm)

- 1. Keep the distance between your wireless speaker and mobile phone (or other devices) within 32.8 Feet.
- 2. Power on the wireless speaker.
- 3. Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone within range and select "BT VOCAL SPEAKER" from the list shown.
- 4. You will hear a beep sound when pairing is successful.

Reconnect Wireless speaker to your mobile device

When powered on, the wireless speaker will automatically connect with the last successfully paired device.

TWS Connection

(Need 2pcs Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker to perform this function.) 1. Make sure all Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker are unpaired from Bluetooth

- 2. Turn off both Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker.
- 3. Turn on both Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker, both Speakers' LED indicator will
- 4. Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker will automatically connect each other in 30. seconds with a tone. One of the LED indicator will stop flash.
- 5. The Vocal+ Wireless Karaoke Speaker with a flashing Blue LED is Host Speaker, only Host speaker will connect with Bluetooth devices.
- 6. Follow "Pair Wireless speaker with your mobile device" to pair Vocal+ Wireless
- Karaoke Speaker.

FM Radio Mode

Switch to FM mode

- Press and hold the Mode button until the speaker responded with a tone.
- Press and hold again will back to Bluetooth mode.

Next Channel

- Short press the Mode button once

Auto Scan

- Short press the Mode button twice.
- Volume Up
- Short press the Mode button three times.

Volume Down

- Short press the Mode button four times.

Charging your Wireless speaker

- 1. Use the Micro USB charging cable provided with this wireless speaker.
- 2. Connect the Micro USB plug to Micro USB charging port on the speaker, then connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to begin charging.

- 3. The light will turn red while charging and will turn off once fully charged. You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Wireless speaker if it has been not used for more than 6 months.



FAQ

- If the Wireless speaker cannot be paired with your device. please try the following:
- Ensure that your speaker is in pairing mode or reconnection mode. Ensure that Bluetooth search function of your mobile device is activated.

If the Wireless speaker cannot be recharged:

If you use a power outlet, ensure that the power supply is connected securely and the outlet works. If you use a computer, ensure that it is connected and the USB port is powered.
