$$S_C = \frac{P_A G_N}{4\pi R_C^2}$$

$$R_C = \sqrt{\frac{P_A G_N}{4\pi S_L}}$$

$$S_L = \frac{180}{f^2} \text{ (mW/cm}^2\text{)}$$

$S_{20}$  = Power Density of the Device at 20cm

$S_L$  = Power Density Limit

$S_C$  = Power Density of the Device at the Compliance Distance  $R_C$

$R_{20}$  = 20cm
