### R/C SF Challenger Cat. No. 60-4245

Your RadioShack Radio-Controlled Challenger is fun for children ages four and up. You can watch it race forward or turn in reverse.

## Installing the batteries:

Your Challenger requires two 'AA' batteries, and its pistol controller requires one 9V battery (neither supplied). For the best performance and longest life, we recommend RadioShack alkaline batteries.

#### Cautions:

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (standard, alkaline, or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.

#### To install the batteries:

- Press the tab of Challenger's battery compartment cover toward the "On/Off" switch and lift to remove it. Use a Philip screw driver to remove the screw on the pistol controller's battery compartment cover, then remove the cover.
- Install two 'AA' batteries into Challenger's battery compartment and one '9V' battery
  into the controller's battery compartment as indicated by the polarity symbols (+ and -)
  marked inside the compartments.
- 3. Replace the covers.

# Operations

- To START Challenger, move switch on bottom of vehicle to "ON" position. The vehicle will remain stationary.
- To drive FORWARD, squeeze and hold trigger on pistol controller and vehicle will race forward in a straight line.
- 3. For racing in REVERSE & TURNING, push trigger on pistol controller upward.
- 4. Set the key to 'OFF' position to turn off the Challenger.

#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To enjoy your Radio-Controlled Challenger for a long time:

- Keep the Challenger dry. If it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately
- Use and store the Challenger only in normal temperature environments.

- Handle the product gently and carefully. Don't drop it.
- · Keep the Challenger away from dust and dirt.
- Wipe the Challenger with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.

Modifying or tampering with the Challenger's internal components can cause a malfunction and invalidate its warranty. If your Challenger is not performing as it should, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance.
